Greetings brother's and sisters in Christ,

Merry Merry "Word Made Flesh" Day! Our Lord is born. God took on our flesh and blood. From Mary, God took on a body that reveals to us our salvation. In our messiness, in the darkness of the night, our Lord comes to us, born of a woman, born to Mary!

I am in awe of God's great mercy and love for us. I am in awe of his willingness to enter into our weakness and littleness. I am in awe of the great mystery of how he chooses to do all of this. Our Lord is here, He is at work even when we are unaware of his presence. In the silent of the night, let us receive him with reverence and openness.






