*Greetings brother's and sisters in Christ,*

Happy New Years and a Blessed Epiphany of the Lord! In this coming week, I am supposed to be taking a group of parishioners on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. As I am writing, the plan is still to go, but things may have changed by now.

This will be my second time in the Holy Land. The first time I went, it was actually a joint pilgrimage with St. Ignatius in Spring (my previous assignment) and parishioners from Most Holy Trinity. I did not know it at the time, but a few months later, God would send me here to Angleton to serve here. In some ways he was preparing me for this change.

The Holy Land is called by St. Jerome as the "Fifth Gospel" because when you read the four gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) in the scriptures the power of the Word-made-flesh comes alive for us. And each of the gospels gives us a different vantage point or a different facet of a beautiful diamond. But when you make a pilgrimage to the Holy Land, you begin to get not only the descriptions and inspired words of the Four Gospels, but you also are able to encounter and experience the land upon which the Son of God chose to reveal himself in the flesh.

It is said that when Jesus was baptized in the Jordan, the waters themselves did not somehow change Jesus Christ, the Son of God, but through the immersion of the Son of God into those waters, it was water itself that was charged with divine efficacy. Through Jesus, water was thus raised to the level of having the ability to take away sin and baptize all who come in faith. In a very real way, the Holy Land has been touched by God and there is something that vibrates in the air that speaks of Him.

If it is the case that we are still going to the Holy Land, I would like to invite you to send your prayer requests to me, so that I can print it out and carry it to the various holy sites to be prayed over. It is a blessing to bring your prayer intentions to the places where Jesus live and ministered and offered his life for us. There are beautiful testimonies of the power of this prayer. ¡¡Feliz Año Nuevo y Bendita Epifanía del Señor! En esta próxima semana, se supone que llevaré a un grupo de feligreses en una peregrinación a Tierra Santa. Mientras escribo, el plan aún está por llegar, pero las cosas pueden haber cambiado a estas alturas.

Esta será mi segunda vez en Tierra Santa. La primera vez que fui, en realidad fue una peregrinación conjunta con San Ignacio en primavera (mi asignación anterior) y feligreses de la Santísima Trinidad. No lo sabía en ese momento, pero unos meses más tarde, Dios me enviaría aquí a Angleton para servir aquí. De alguna manera me estaba preparando para este cambio.

La Tierra Santa es llamada por San Jerónimo como el "Quinto Evangelio" porque cuando lees los cuatro evangelios (Mateo, Marcos, Lucas y Juan) en las Escrituras, el poder de la Palabra hecha carne cobra vida para nosotros. Y cada uno de los evangelios nos da un punto de vista diferente o una faceta diferente de un hermoso diamante. Pero cuando haces una peregrinación a Tierra Santa, comienzas a obtener no solo las descripciones y las palabras inspiradas de los Cuatro Evangelios, sino que también puedes encontrar y experimentar la tierra sobre la cual el Hijo de Dios eligió revelarse en la carne.

Se dice que cuando Jesús fue bautizado en el Jordán, las aguas mismas no cambiaron de alguna manera a Jesucristo, el Hijo de Dios, pero a través de la inmersión del Hijo de Dios en esas aguas, fue el agua misma la que fue cargada de eficacia divina. A través de Jesús, el agua fue elevada al nivel de tener la capacidad de quitar el pecado y bautizar a todos los que vienen en fe. De una manera muy real, tierra santa ha sido tocada por Dios y hay algo que vibra en el aire que habla de Él.

Si es el caso de que todavía vamos a Tierra Santa, me gustaría invitarlos a que me envíen sus peticiones de oración, para que pueda imprimirlas y llevarlas a los diversos lugares sagrados para ser oradas. Es una bendición llevar sus intenciones de oración a los lugares donde Jesús vive, ministró y ofreció su vida por nosotros. Hay hermosos testimonios del poder de esta oración. 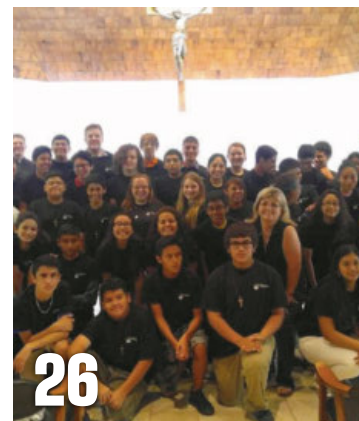

## CHRISTMAS COMMEMORATIVE PAVER SPECIAL

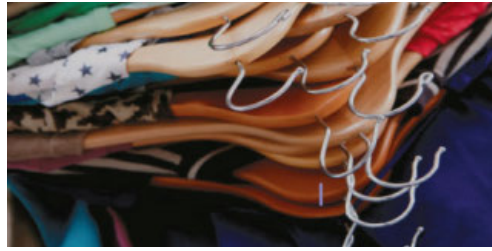
Are you looking for a unique gift for someone on your Christmas list this year, or would you like to commemorate the loss of a special someone?

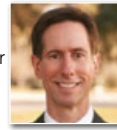
