Greetings brother's and sisters in Christ,

I hope your new year has begun well, and if not, I hope that the rest of the year will be blessed. There are lots of great things happening here at MHT. As we are returning back to normalcy, with Holy Water back into the font and Mass obligatory on Sundays, sharing the Sign of Peace again, I am returning to the normal options of reception of Communion. In September, I had asked that all those who receive communion on the tongue receive it on the right side of the sanctuary and only those who receive it on the hand receive communion on the left side. This was a temporary measure during the surge and was not meant to be permanent. I know that there are still much fear around the virus, but I believe we should place our trust in the Lord.

As regarding reception of communion on the tongue or the hand, there is lots of misunderstanding and thus confusion. Many think that Vatican II did away with reception of the Eucharist on the tongue, when in fact it did not. The Church's norm for receiving communion is on the tongue. This has been the tradition of the Church for centuries. After Vatican II, there was permission to request Rome for the option from this norm of receiving communion in the hand. Because of the popular practice, the USCCB did request for this option. Nevertheless, reception of the Eucharist on the tongue is still the norm.

"The most ancient practice of distributing Holy Communion was, with all probability, to give Communion to the faithful in the palm of the hand. The history of the liturgy, however, makes clear that rather early on a process took place to change this practice. From the time of the Fathers of the Church, a tendency was born and consolidated whereby distribution of Holy Communion in the hand became more and more restricted in favor of distributing Holy Communion on the tongue. The motivation for this practice is two-fold: a) first, to avoid, as much as possible, the dropping of Eucharistic particles; b) second, to increase among the faithful devotion to the Real Presence of Christ in the Sacrament of the Eucharist." "The communicant may choose whether to receive the Body of Christ in the hand or on the tongue. When receiving in the hand, the communicant should be guided by the words of St. Cyril of Jerusalem: "When you approach, take care not to do so with your hand stretched out and your fingers open or apart, but rather place your left hand as a throne beneath your right, as befits one who is about to receive the King. Then receive him, taking care that nothing is lost." (General Instruction of the Roman Missal, 41).

No matter how we choose to receive the Body of Christ, let us do so with great awareness that it is truly and really Jesus Christ that we are receiving, and may our attitude towards this reception be a witness to others of this great gift!

Saludos hermanos y hermanas,

Espero que tu año nuevo haya comenzado bien, y si no, espero que el resto del año sea bendecido. Están sucediendo muchas cosas maravillosas aquí en MHT. Mientras volvemos a la normalidad, con el Agua Bendita de nuevo en la fuente y la Misa obligatoria los Domingos, compartiendo de nuevo el Signo de la Paz, estoy volviendo a las opciones normales de recepción de la Comunión. En septiembre había pedido que todos los que comulgaran en la lengua la recibieran del lado derecho del santuario y sólo los que la comulgaran en la mano recibieran la comunión del lado izquierdo. Esta fue una medida temporal durante la oleada y no estaba destinada a ser permanente. Sé que todavía hay mucho miedo en torno al virus, pero creo que debemos poner nuestra confianza en el Señor.

En cuanto a la recepción de la comunión en la lengua o la mano, hay muchos malentendidos y, por lo tanto, confusión. Muchos piensan que el Vaticano II eliminó la recepción de la Eucaristía en la lengua, cuando en realidad no fue así. La norma de la Iglesia para recibir la comunión está en la lengua. Esta ha sido la tradición de la Iglesia durante siglos. Después del Concilio Vaticano II, hubo permiso para solicitar a Roma la opción de esta norma de recibir la comunión en la mano. Debido a la práctica popular, la USCCB solicitó esta opción. Sin embargo, la recepción de la Eucaristía en la lengua sigue siendo la norma.

"La práctica más antigua de distribuir la Sagrada Comunión era, con toda probabilidad, dar la Comunión a los fieles en la palma de la mano. La historia de la liturgia, sin embargo, deja claro que bastante pronto tuvo lugar un proceso para cambiar esta práctica. Desde la época de los Padres de la Iglesia, nació y se consolidó una tendencia según la cual la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión en la mano se restringía cada vez más a favor de la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión en la lengua. La motivación de esta práctica es doble: a) primero, evitar, en lo posible, la caída de partículas eucarísticas; b) segundo, aumentar entre los fieles la devoción a la Presencia Real de Cristo en el Sacramento de la Eucaristía." "El comulgante puede elegir si recibir el Cuerpo de Cristo en la mano o en la lengua. Al recibir en la mano, el comulgante debe guiarse por las palabras de San Cirilo de Jerusalén: "Cuando te acerques, cuídate de no hacerlo con la mano extendida y los dedos abiertos o separados, sino coloca la mano izquierda como un trono debajo de tu derecha, como corresponde a quien está para recibir al Rey. Luego recíbelo, cuidando que nada se pierda". (Instrucción General del Misal Romano, 41).

¡No importa cómo elijamos recibir el Cuerpo de Cristo, hagámoslo con gran conciencia de que es verdadera y realmente a Jesucristo a quien estamos recibiendo, y que nuestra actitud hacia esta recepción sea un testimonio para otros de este gran don!

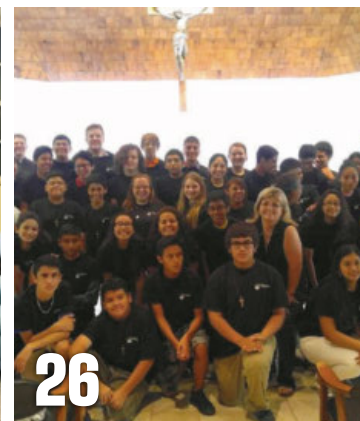

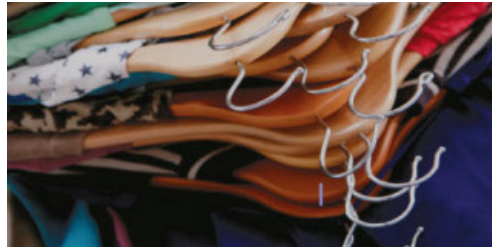
