As you have heard me announce these past weeks, we are doing many events each month throughout the year to celebrate 25 years as Most Holy Trinity Catholic Church. This month we will be working at organizing some gardening days.

Easter will be next month, and normally we have many beautiful celebrations during Holy Week to relive and experience again the power and beauty of God's saving love. In the past few years, we have had outdoor Live Stations of the Cross (Viacrucis) around the neighborhood. And thanks for the hard work of Marcela Loya and many many others, this has been a beautiful and prayerful experience for many people. We also have the All-You-Can-Eat Fish Fry in St. Basil Hall from 5-7pm on Fridays. Let us come together this Lent as one community to remember and celebrate all that the Lord has done for us!

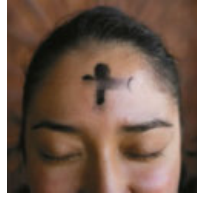

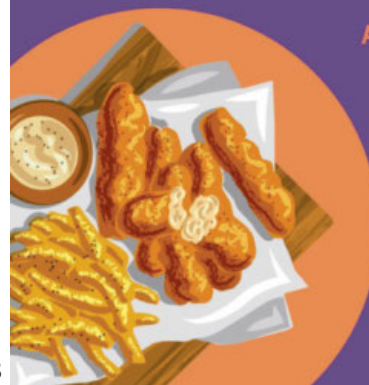

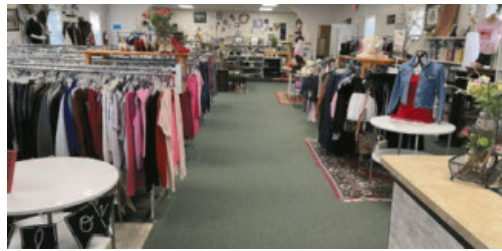
