

Pastor's Letter:

17 October, 2021

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you..."

James and John are boldly telling God what to do. This is usually a very bad idea, and this is no different, but Jesus patiently lets them ask their impertinent, but impossible, request:

"Grant that in your glory we may sit one at your right and the other at your left."

James and John were not to know, but we know that **those seats were taken**: Jesus sits **at the right hand of the Father**, so logically neither James nor John could not sit at Jesus' left; the Queen of the Kingdom, Mary, Our Blessed Mother, traditionally sits at Jesus right. Jesus tells us in another parable not to seek the best seat but rather to sit at the lowest place so that we will be invited up higher.

"Rather, whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first

among you will be the slave of all."

This is pretty heavy stuff. The very idea of serving might scare some of us. However, it is an incredible act of one's will to answer YES to a commitment to serve God.

We have to give what is alive in us: faith, our joy, our kindness, our confidence, and our hope that sustains us. To give your life in service is a generous gesture that enriches many, helps others, gives to others, that redeems souls, that liberates and saves people and **Sr. Mary Beverly** will be showing us just how to do this....




As we emerge more and more from the COVID-19 Pandemic, the need for charitable works by organizations like the Knights of Columbus will be more than ever. If you are look-

St. John Paul II | October 22

Karol Wojtyla was born in the small Polish town of Wadowice. During WWII, he studied for the priesthood in an underground seminary. He was ordained in 1946, appointed Archbishop in 1964, and in 1967 became a cardinal. In 1978, he was elected the 264th pope, and took the name John Paul II.

In 1981, he was shot twice in an assassination attempt. Following Jesus' example of compassion, he met with his would-be assassin in his prison cell, where he forgave him.

Near the end of his papacy, his poor health made public appearances difficult. Still, he continued his pastoral work. He died April 2, 2005, and he was declared a saint on April 27, 2014.




