

# **Pastor's Letter:** 24 October, 2021 **30th Sunday** in Ordinary Time

#### "Take courage, He is calling you."

We have a spiritual classic as a Gospel reading today, a miraculous story of healing and of conversion. Bartimaeus was begging from the great many Passover pilgrims by the roadside in Jericho, a place synonymous with sin. It is the lowest city in the world.

Now we don't know much about Bartimaeus, except that he was the son of Timaeus and that he had heard of Jesus. We don't know how long he had been blind. He may have been lukewarm with a habit of indifference to What did Bartimaeus do after his sight was God's grace. He may have been too busy with restored? He followed Jesus along the road. In other things for too long... he may have had a the Gospels when we read that someone folspiritual apathy: he didn't really say "no" but lowed Jesus it means he became a disciple of "not now."

Regarding spiritual apathy, God says, "I know your works; I know that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were cold or hot. So because you are lukewarm, neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth" (Rev. 3:15-16).

#### "Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me."

After people tried to silence him, Jesus said:

"Call him." Then others changed their tune and said, "Take courage, He is calling you." The man threw aside his cloak, a symbol of his wretched, sinful state. If you have ever been given a second chance, you will probably know how he felt.

He sprang up and following the voice came bumping and stumbling excitedly towards Jesus, who asks the poor, blind man directly:

#### "What do you want me to do for you?"



You see, Jesus wants us to

cooperate with Him in His work. He wants our personal buy-in.

Bartimaeus replies, "Master, I want to see." Jesus told him, "Go your way; your faith has saved you" and he received his sight we are told immediately. God does not wait!

This was Jesus' last healing miracle before His passion and death. Bartimaeus, healed, with his sight, followed Jesus without reservation. He became a follower of Jesus to Jerusalem.

Jesus. Jesus had twelve apostles but he had many disciples-He still has: all of us here! We call out to Jesus, He calls us and sends us out into the world to bring in the lost sheep.
