

# Pastor's Letter: 19 December, 2021

Fourth Sunday of Advent

# O COME, O COME Emmanuel, The DIVINE MESSIAH

When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit cried out in a loud voice,

# "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb!"

On this Fourth Sunday of Advent, we come to the Visitation of Mary, who brings Jesus to her cousin Elizabeth. When Mary said to the Angel Gabriel, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord! May it be done to me according to your word," she became the Mother of God, and went in haste to visit Elizabeth who was with child. Mary our Mother brings Jesus to us, and us to Him. The easiest and surest way to grow in holiness, in a love relationship with Jesus, is through Mary. Here is a Christmas Novena Prayer which can be prayed in your home leading up to Christmas Day:

"Hail and blessed be the hour and moment in which the Son of God was born of the most

pure Virgin Mary, at midnight, in Bethlehem, in piercing cold.

In that hour, vouch safe, O my God! to hear my prayer and grant my de

sires, through the merits of Our Saviour Jesus Christ, and of His Blessed Mother. Amen.


## **Christmas Mass Obligation**


