

## The Fourth Sunday

in Ordinary Time:

"But I shall show you a still more excellent way" (1 Cor 12:31).

I am sure this Gospel account of the Rejection at Nazareth left Our Lord Jesus shaking his head in bewilderment. Yet, He continued on in His ministry. Difficult as it was, He had to move on from His home to another place where His Love would be accepted:

"There is a sense in which faith and hope, in their current form, pass away. But love doesn't pass away. In that sense, the greatest of the three theological virtues: faith, hope, and love - is love. Because as St. Thérèse says in her Story of a Soul, because love is eternal... or as Paul himself says, because love never ends"

(Dr. Brant Pitre).

#### HAND-CARVED IN BETHLEHEM

Our good friend, Ayman Khair, is representing 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the Pandemic, tourism has been stopped completely since March 2, 2020.

It is very important to support them at this critical time, due to their lack of income and no government to help or take care of them. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the US to purchase their articles.

These hand carved religious articles are beyond description. Carved from wood of the sacred Olive tree, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years.

It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income, are able to stay living and survive in the Holy Land. Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support




