



March 6, 2022

First Sunday Of Lent:

Lent: A Season of Hope*

Lord, in these difficult times, we enter into the desert of Lent this year on our annual Journey to Jerusalem with much grief in our hearts for those lost to us... the bullets and missiles in Ukraine. the tortured cries of children of abuse, the rhetoric and spin of governments, those still living in fear of the pandemic,

Yet we turn to these words of Hope:

"The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us... and we saw his glory... full of grace and truth."

Why Did God Become Human?

There are two ways of looking at this:

- 1. The Sin-centered view: where humans are the central focus.
- becomes the central focus.

Both views have been the discussion and understanding in the Church for centuries. There is no definite doctoral statement on 2. Who do we need to reach out to, listen to, either one. They stand side by side.

The context of our view shapes the way we see God, creation sacrifice and sin...

Jesus loves you and came in love to save you. Have you ever thought about that?

Jesus loves YOU. Jesus loves YOU! Now. He wants you to fall in love with Him.

This is the reason for our hope*.

In the Desert, Jesus Leads Us To **Holiness Of Life.**

"Jesus' temptation reveals the way in which the Son of God is Messiah, contrary to the way Satan proposes to him and the way men wish to attribute to him. This is why Christ vanquished the Tempter for us: "For we have not a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sinning."

"By the solemn forty days of *Lent* the Church unites herself each year to the mystery of Jesus in the desert" (CCC 540).

As a Church, as the Bride of the Bridegroom, Jesus, we are invited to make the most out of this time of Lent, in order that we grow into deeper union with Jesus and so conform ourselves to Jesus Christ.



Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

This year we are welcoming William Gore, Luke McCracken, and Tyler Wells through the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. On the first Sunday of Lent, March 6th at the 11 am mass they will be receiving the Rite of Election. This is where they will sign the Book of Elect. This is called Election because the acceptance made by the Church is founded on the election by God, in whose name the Church acts. The step is also called the enrollment of names because as a pledge of fidelity the candidates inscribe their names in the book that lists those who have been chosen for initiation.

These Elect will also receive prayers known as Scrutinies on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sunday of Lent. These prayers are minor exorcisms that help the Elect receive strength against the evil one who is trying to prevent them from being received into the Church through the Sacraments of Initiation. On these Sundays at the 11 am mass we will be taking the Cycle A readings that focus on the mystery of sin, from which the whole world and every person longs to be delivered and thus saved from it present and future consequences. Second, their spirit is filled with Christ the Redeemer, and who is the living water (the gospel of the Samaritan woman in the first scrutiny), the light of the world (the gospel of the man born blind in the second scrutiny), the resurrection and the life (gospel of Lazarus in the Third Scrutiny).
