

March 13 2022

Second Sunday Of Lent:

Christ's Transfiguration

Continuing Our Hope for Lent:

the transforming power of prayer in finding our way and facing struggles with hope.

Jesus went up the mountain to pray. It is in Trinity. praying that Jesus is transformed and his clothes become dazzling white. Reflecting on Jesus in glory will transform us. No wonder the readings favor clouds, shadows, light, fire, mountain tops and utter silence.

In hope we set our sights toward Easter to enter more deeply the mystery of Jesus' death and resurrection.

Jesus is at a turning point in his life. He sees his life from Nazareth, Galilee and now, Jerusalem. At the spirit's urging he went into the Monday, March 28th 8:45AM & 4:45PM desert to prepare. It is the spirit's urging that brings us to Jesus to prepare.

He prepares Abraham with the words: "Look up." and to us... "Listen to him..." St. Paul tells us "our citizenship is in heaven..." Jesus, will change our "lowly bodies to conform with his glorified body..." These words are our hope, do we believe that Jesus can do this in us?

Luke's Gospel has a different ending than Mark and Matthew on the Transfiguration...

Peter, James and John are silent...and did not speak about their experience at that time. The intimacy and awe of the moment drew them to silence. May we draw away each day to let Jesus' love hold us in a cloud to experience real (Meditation by Marty Ann Ronan). hope


