## **Pastor's Letter:**

May 1, 2022

### **Much More Divine Mercy: "It Is The Lord"**

**"Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches, wisdom and strength, honor and glory and blessing"**

(Revelation 5:12).

Our Lord Jesus is worthy of all of our love and gratitude. He first loved us and gave His Life for us. In today's Gospel, Our Risen Lord Jesus asks Peter three times if he loves Him, and each time Peter says yes. Peter became distressed that Jesus had said to Him a third time, "Do you love me?"

Jesus was healing Peter's triple denial of Him during Jesus' Passion. The First Vatican Council cited these verses in defining that Jesus after his resurrection gave Peter the position of supreme shepherd and ruler over the Church.

After Jesus' Resurrection and Ascension, the Father and the Son sent the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, as we read in the Acts of the Apostles.

In today's First Reading from Acts, we hear St. Peter boldly proclaiming the Death and Resurrection of Jesus at the risk of being arrested and condemned by the Sanhedrin.

We know that St. Peter was martyred for his love for Jesus and His Church "Amen, amen, I say to you, when you were younger, you used to dress yourself and go where you wanted; but when you grow old, you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go." Jesus said this signifying by what kind of death he would glorify God.

And when he had said this, he said to him,

## **"Follow Me."**



Thank God that St. Peter did follow Jesus from that day on and that he was martyred by crucifixion in Rome. St. Peter said "Yes" to Jesus and with his love and life said,

## **"Yes, Lord, I love you."**

St. Peter did as Jesus asked; as the first Pope, he fed the lambs, tended the sheep, fed the sheep. We see in the Gospel, how Jesus in His tenderness and love, called Peter to turn completely toward Him and to follow Him. Jesus brought about the conversion of His Apostles gradually, with the exception of St. Paul who experienced an instantaneous conversion.

Ask the Holy Spirit for the grace to love God with all of your heart, all of your soul and mind; ask Him for the grace to persevere in loving Him. Charity, or Love, toward God is strengthened. "In this is charity, in this is love: not that we have loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as expiation for our sins. (I John 4:10)

Our Beloved Jesus, God Himself, asks you,

**"Do You Love Me? Do You Know Me?"**

**How do you plan to show Jesus just how much you love Him? Do something.**

**Get involved! Try something. Cast a Net...**

**Jesus will be there for you. He will fill your nets to overflowing, especially when they are empty and we are exhausted.**

**He will lead you, teach you and feed you.**

He feeds **our newly-confirmed apostles** this weekend with His strength. Our prayers and heartfelt congratulations go out to them.
