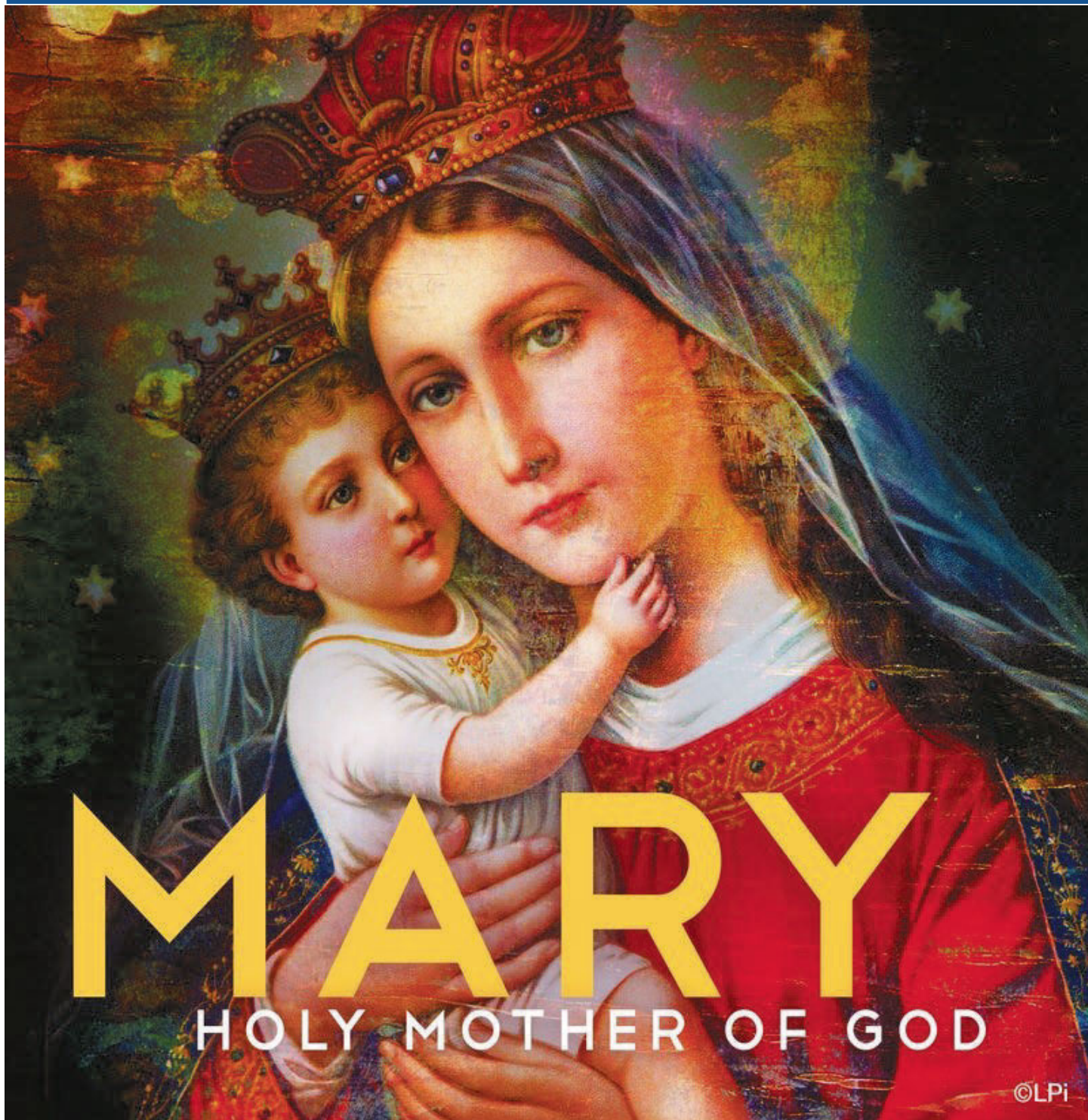

Pastor's Letter:

January 1, 2023

The Octave Day of Christmas

The Great Solemnity of

Mary, The Mother of God.

“When eight days were completed for his circumcision, he was named Jesus, the name given him by the angel before he was conceived in the womb” (Luke 2: 21).

And Mary kept all these things,
reflecting on them in her heart.

Today the entire Church celebrates Mary, the Mother of God. Jesus, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, is the Word Who became Flesh and dwelt among us, being born for us from the womb of Mary (John 1:14).

There are many beautiful hymns to Mary. The most beloved is the “Ave Maria”, the Hail Mary in Latin. Another Latin hymn, “Tota Pulchra Es, Maria,” “You are All Beautiful Mary” addresses Mary with love. The Latin words tell “original sin was not in You”; “You are the glory of Jerusalem! You are the joy of Israel! You are the honor of our race! You are the Advocate of all sinners! Pray for us merciful Mother who cares for us.”

The Father’s only Son, conceived as man in the womb of the Virgin Mary, is “Christ” the anointed by the Holy Spirit from the beginning of His human existence.

The manifestation of this fact takes place progressively: to the shepherds, to the magi, to John the Baptist, to the disciples. Thus, the whole life of Jesus Christ will make manifest ‘how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power.’”

(Catechism of the Catholic Church, CCC 484-486)

The Annunciation to Mary begins the “fullness of time;” when God fulfills His promises and preparations. Mary said “Yes” to the Father’s will, and She conceived Jesus through the power of the Holy Spirit.



“Throughout the Old Covenant the mission of many holy women prepared for that of Mary. At the very beginning was Eve; despite her disobedience, she receives the promise of a posterity that will be victorious over the evil one, as well as the promise that she will be the mother of all the living. By virtue of this promise, Sarah conceives a son despite her old age. Against all human expectation God chooses those who were considered powerless and weak to show forth His faithfulness to His promises: Hannah, the mother of Samuel; Deborah, Ruth, Judith and Esther and many other women. Mary stands out among the poor and humble of the Lord, who confidently hope for and received salvation from Him. After a long period of waiting the times are fulfilled in Her, the exalted Daughter of Sion, and the new plan of salvation is established.” (CCC, 489).

“Mary’s role in the Church is inseparable from Her union with Her Son Jesus Christ; Her role flows directly from this union with Him. Mary’s role in the work of your and my salvation in Christ is made manifest from the moment of Christ’s virginal conception up to His death; it is made manifest especially during the hour of His Passion: “there She stood, in keeping with the divine plan, enduring with her only begotten Son the intensity of His suffering, joining Herself with His sacrifice in Her mother’s heart, and lovingly consenting to the immolation of this victim, born of Her: to be given, by the same Christ Jesus dying on the cross, as a mother to His disciple, with these words: ‘Woman, behold your Son.’”

(CCC, 964)

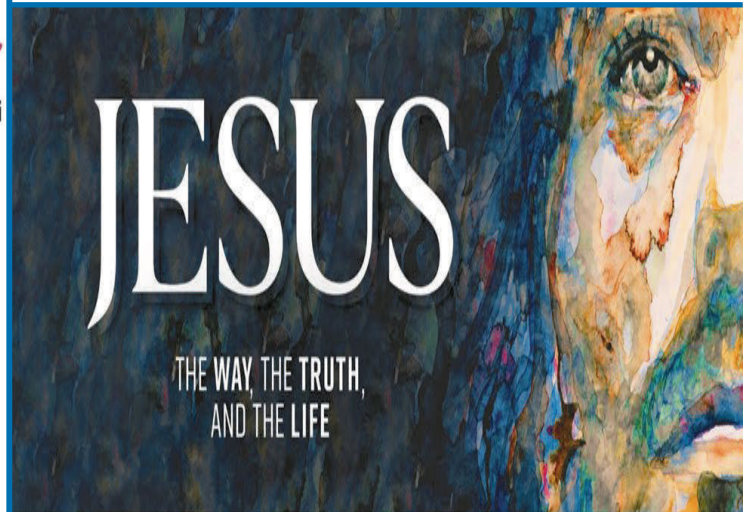
(RCIA) The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

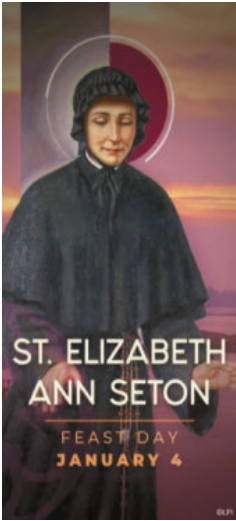

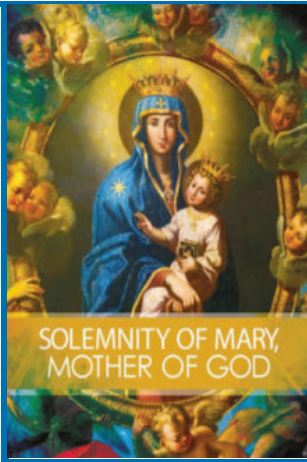


Feast of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton January 4th

The patron saint of Catholic schools, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (August 28, 1774 – January 4, 1821) was born in New York City to a prominent family of the Episcopal faith. When she turned 19, she married a wealthy businessman with whom she had five children. He later died of tuberculosis in 1803, leaving her

a young widow. After discovering the Catholic faith in Italy, where her husband had died, she returned to New York and converted to Catholicism in 1805.

After several years struggling as a single mother, Elizabeth moved in 1809 to Emmitsburg, Maryland, where she founded the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph, the first community for religious women established in the United States. She also began St. Joseph's Academy and Free School, which started a chain reaction of Catholic-based education in the United States that continues today. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton was canonized September 14, 1975 in St. Peter's Square by Pope Paul VI and was the first citizen born in the United States to be given the title of "saint."
