Pastor's Letter: **WORD of GOD**

SUNDAY

“Jesus opened their minds to understand the Scriptures” we read in *Luke 24:45*.

This Scripture from the resurrection account of the appearance on the Road to Emmaus is how Pope Francis opens his recent Apostolic Letter instituting the first **Sunday of the Word of God.** “All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for refutation, for correction, and for training in righteousness, so that one who belongs to God may be competent, equipped for every good work.”

In his great book, *The Introduction to the Scriptures*, Dr. Scott Hahn explains clearly:

“The Bible is the **inspired** and **inerrant** Word of God. In just 73 books, it gives us the history of God's plan for our salvation, beginning with the creation of the world and ending with the beginnings of the Christian Church. Together with the teaching of the Church, the Bible tells us what we need to know in order to be saved.” Sacred Scripture is defined as both **Inspired** and **inerrant**.

“**Inspired**” is from the word meaning to “breathe in” and means that God Himself guided the authors who wrote the books of the Bible. The writers’ minds and intellects were enlightened directly by the Spirit to write what God wanted and nothing more. This writing process took place over several thousand years and gave us the Bible today.

“**Inerrant**” means that it does not make mistakes, properly understood. Scripture always teaches truth, never mistakes.

The Bible is The Story of Our Faith.

Start With A Bible Enthronement

I urge you to **Enthron**e your Bible at home to show that God is at the center of your life and family. Many people already enthrone the Bible in a visible place in their homes. By placing the Sacred Scriptures in a quiet, yet prominent place in the home, decorated with a white cloth and adorned with a candle, sacred art and flowers and by gathering at this place for daily prayer, families show that God is present and active in our life through his Word. This can be a place to proudly show visitors to your home and provide a beautiful location to pray and meditate. You may wish to open your Bible to a favorite passage or to one of the readings of the day you can study.

How Can I Tell If My Bible is Catholic?

Catholic and Protestant Bibles both include 27 books in the New Testament. A Catholic Bible has 46 books of the Old Testament - 7 more than a non-Catholic Bible. These 7 books are 1 & 2 Maccabees, Judith, Wisdom, Tobit, Sirach, and Baruch. Catholic Bibles also include sections in the Books of Esther and Daniel. They are called the deuterocanonical books. The Catholic Church believes these books to be inspired by the Holy Spirit.

There’s also a Latin word **Imprimatur** which means ‘Let it be printed’ - a permission by a bishop for the publication of any work on Scripture.

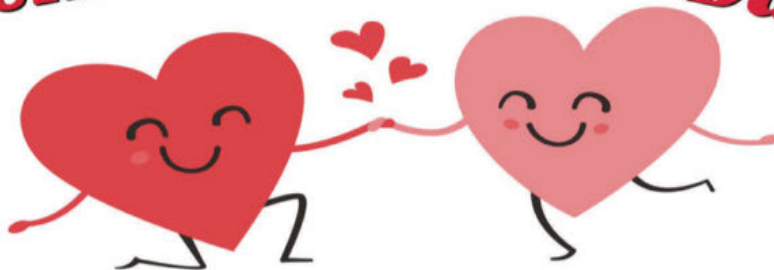

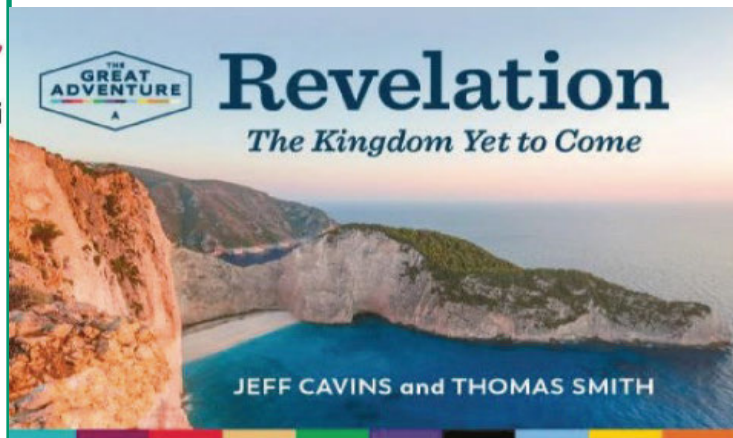
(RCIA) The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

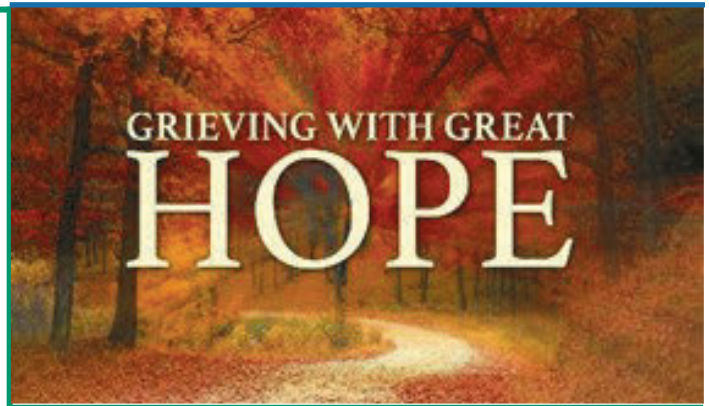

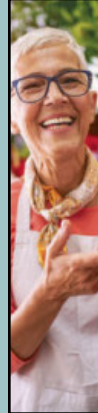
