Pastor's Letter:
 January 29, 2023
The Beatitudes
**God's Roadmap
 to Happiness**

As I mentioned last weekend, we are so blessed to be living in these present times. We are so blessed in this day and age to have so much technology to help us navigate and get around as well as to communicate and learn about the things of God.

The Beatitudes begin the most famous sermon Jesus preached, **the Sermon on the Mount**. What he says was new, radical, shocking even, and packs a powerful, challenging message in nine points we cannot miss.

Have you ever had the Beatitudes explained more simply? Have you considered how they apply to your life every day? Beatitudes mark the fulfillment of God's covenant promise to Abraham—that through his descendants all the nations of the world would receive God's blessings and to Moses, **both on mountains in the Old Testament**.

“Through the wisdom He speaks today, Jesus, the son of Abraham, bestows the Father's blessings upon “the poor in spirit.” God has chosen to bless the weak and lowly, those foolish and despised in the eyes of the world, Paul says in today's Epistle. The poor in spirit are those who know that nothing they do can merit God's mercy and grace. These are the humble remnant in the first reading, taught to trust and seek refuge in the name of the Lord” as Dr. Scott Hahn writes.

The Beatitudes are God's path and purpose for our faith lives, Christian virtues to be gentle, kind and clean of heart; merciful and makers of peace; seekers of the righteousness that come from living by the law of Kingdom.
