

Pastor's Letter:

March 19, 2023

The Light of **Divine Love:**

The Healing of the Man Born Blind

"I do believe, Lord," and he worshiped him. We are all called closer to the Light. We are all children of the Light. God calls us to a deeper conversion.

Those who take part in the Rite of **Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)** are tested with the Three "Scrutinies" and we will bring our candidates and catechumens to this light on Sunday.

Jesus is presented as Water, Light and Life.

Dr. Scott Hahn beautifully explains this as:

The Enlightenment of Conversion:

"God's ways of seeing are not our ways, we hear in today's First Reading. Jesus illustrates this in the Gospel as the blind man comes to see and the Pharisees are made blind.

"The blind man stands for all humanity.

"Born totally in sin," he is made a new creation by the saving power of Christ. As God fashioned the first man from the clay of the earth Jesus gives the blind man new life by anointing his eyes with clay. As God breathed the spirit of life into the first man, the blind man is not healed until he washes in the waters of Siloam, a name that means "Sent."

He was sent and he obeyed in Faith.

How Hard It Is For Those Who Cannot See or Who Do Not Wish to See:

"How hard it is for those who think they can already see, those who want no other light but their own, those who



don't know how to doubt or question!

"They cannot see, they do not want to see, they do not allow themselves to see.

"How can they be enlightened by the Light of the world? Remember what Jesus said to the Pharisees: "If you were blind, you would not have sin; but since you say, 'we see', then your sin remains." If we acknowledge our blindness, then Christ will enlighten us, little by little, until we reach the fullness of day in His divine presence.

"We must travel a long road of purification. We must shine light on all the dark places There are three themes from St. John's Gospel within us, and we must "clean" them by conon these 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent: tact with the word of Jesus. He is the Light that overcomes all darkness,

> "He conquers death, He guides and directs us, He communicates the truth, and He leads us to salvation and joy" (www.epriest.com),

> In the restful waters of Baptism, God has refreshed our souls. He has anointed our heads with the oil of Confirmation and spread the Eucharistic table before us, filling our cups to overflowing. With the once-blind man we enter His house to give God the praise, to renew our vow: "I do believe, Lord."

> We wish to see the needs of our community, to put a special emphasis on helping the poor and the elderly in our parish.

> I will be away on a Grief To Grace Retreat this week. We could really use your prayers.




