## Pastor's Letter:

May 14, 2023

## Sixth Sunday of Easter:

“In My Father's House there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?”

### The Mass is The Wedding Feast

You will recall from last week, we considered the **Groom's Promise**. Just before leaving the house of the bride's father at the engagement ritual, the groom would speak these words to his beloved:

“I go to prepare a place for you in my father's house that where I am you also may be.”

We are now building up to the great Feasts of the **Ascension and Pentecost** and today we hear some key information as we continue to read from the **Last Supper Discourse** from **John, Chapter 14**. This was Jesus' farewell, but it was just for three days—and the three days that changed the world forever.

**This last Sunday before the Ascension**, when Jesus left our world, the House of the Bride, this Spirit of God's Love in faithfulness to His commandments are His last words to us.

When a friend departs we tell them how much we love them, we recall together with them our experiences, and we make promises to keep in contact. As the Words of Institution of the Mass are new, this promise is the new language of the spirit of love. As Jesus prepares for His Passion, he speaks these words for all people, for all eternity.

“If you love me,  
you will keep  
my commandments.”



You would never tell a loved one: “If you love me, you will do what I say.”

But Jesus is much more than our friend: he is our God and Creator. So by keeping the Ten Commandments, we show our love for Christ and for God in a very real and practical way.

The Last Supper was celebrated in a different way than the normal Passover. God is calling us to take notice and to listen up. This is new, this is different. Following the Law blindly is not what Jesus is calling his disciples to do.

Jesus is calling his disciples to keep his commandments out of love for him, because they are his gift to us.

They are a gift that will lead us down the path, not just to eternal life, but they will also help us to have a life of happiness, to have a life of joy in the Holy Spirit and in the Lord.

### The Language of the Love of God

Just as Jesus promised to go and prepare a place for those who love him (the Ascension) and come back again but before that he will send us the Spirit of truth from the Father. Leading on from this study of the law we now have the Promise of the Spirit. We see the promised gift of His Spirit being conferred on the Samaritans in today's First Reading.

Jesus asks the Father to give us His Spirit, a Love to dwell with us and keep us united in the life He shares with the Father.

**This love is reflected in a Mother's Love.**

In the Gospel today, Jesus says:  
“If you love me, you will keep my  
commandments...Whoever loves  
Me will be loved by my father and

I will love him and reveal myself to him. By doing this  
we express our love for our Lord and acceptance of  
our relationship with him. We are also called to keep  
his two Great Commandments, i.e., to love God with  
our whole heart ...and to love our neighbors as our-  
selves.

When we show our love for our neighbors who call on  
us, we are indeed keeping these commandments.  
When we help the poor with **your** gifts, we represent  
**you**.

God indeed pours out his love and joy in your hearts  
and ours and the hearts of those we serve.

With the continually rising rents, we are finding that  
even those who are doing well can be severely im-  
pacted by the loss of one or two paychecks. They  
may not be able to pay their rent when due and they  
then risk eviction. We are most grateful for your con-  
tinued generosity but also ask for your prayers to  
solve the affordable housing crisis in our community  
and for our leaders to prioritize efforts to address this  
challenge.
