Pastor's Letter:
May 21, 2023
Ascension
Sunday



“And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age” (Mt 28:20).

In the Breaking of the Bread at Mass, Jesus, the Body of Christ, is with us always.

Jesus ministry began with His 40 days in the desert and ended with His 40 days of glory. The Risen Christ is finally taken up into His Glory. Jesus glorious wounds are fresh in the memory of His eleven apostles as well as the newly-chosen Matthias. Some followers had scattered, while others went home north to Galilee. Yet they were all back in Jerusalem to witness Jesus' last earthly work, the mystery of **The Ascension**, when they saw Him rise up to Heaven and were filled with amazement as ***He went to prepare a place for them and us.***

I have spoken a lot about the rich Scripture readings this Easter. Season. This language of the love of God at the Last Supper is reflected in the **Groom's Promise** of going to prepare a place for his bride in His Father's house.

The Catechism of The Catholic Church teaches us in Paragraph 648:

"Christ's Ascension, like his Resurrection, is not only about him, it is also about us" We are called to this same Heavenly destiny as Jesus Body where we too will one day live in Heaven in heavenly, resurrected bodies.

When you stop and think about it, the simple bread and wine that we bring as the fruits of our work, is elevated in the Mass, lifted up to the very highest level of being, really and truly the Body of Christ and the Son of God!

“I have not yet ascended to the Father; but go to my brethren and say to them, I am going to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God” (John 20:17).

660 “The veiled character of the glory of the Risen One during this time is intimated in his mysterious words to Mary Magdalene:

This indicates a difference in manifestation between the glory of the risen Christ and that of the Christ exalted to the Father's right hand, a transition marked by the historical and transcendent event of the Ascension.

661 This final stage stays closely linked to the first, that is, to his descent from heaven in the Incarnation. Only the one who “came from the Father” can return to the Father: Christ Jesus

“No one has ascended into heaven but he who descended from heaven, the Son of man.” Left to its own natural powers humanity does not have access to the "Father's house", to God's life and happiness. Only Christ can open to man such access that we, his members, might have confidence that we too shall go where he, our Head and our Source, has preceded us.

662 “And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself.” The lifting up of Jesus on the cross signifies and announces his lifting up by his Ascension into heaven, and indeed begins it. Jesus Christ, the one priest of the new and eternal Covenant, "entered, not into a sanctuary made by human hands. . . but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf.”

The Ascension of the Lord May 21, 2023

Today we are reminded of the importance of the feast of the Ascension.

We are told that Jesus accomplished his ministry while on earth and is returned to his heavenly home to prepare a place for us. As believers we know that we, too, will leave this earth; however, the gift of the Ascension assures us that we will also be raised. After Jesus' Ascension his saving work on earth continued through his disciples and now... **through us.**

The parish's Society conference members **THANK YOU** for making it possible for us to join with conferences throughout the state to respond to the community's needs. Below are some of the services that were provided in 2022. 3.25 million meals served; 45,208 shelter nights to neighbors working to end their homelessness; \$7 million in rent and utility assistance helped families avoid eviction; 6.2 million pounds of food received and distributed through our Central Food Bank; 14,562 medical, dental and wellness visits at our charity clinic; 30,200 lbs. of fresh produce harvested in our Urban Farms to complement meals and food boxes; 208,000 service hours completed by 14,000 committed and compassionate volunteers. **Additionally, YOUR generous donations allowed our conference to provide over \$12,600 in rental assistance last month! Jesus' saving work continues.....**

In two weeks, **June 3rd and 4th**, we will be having our **jean and T-shirt** drive for the homeless. Donation boxes will be located outside the Society's pantry (near the east parking lot), at each of the church entrances and in the church vestibule. Donations may be dropped off **Saturday, June 3 from 7-9 a.m. and 3-5 p.m. Sunday, June 4 hours are from 6 a.m. to noon**

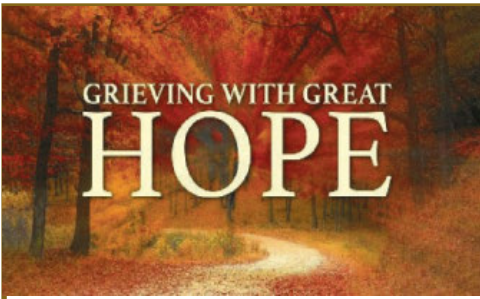

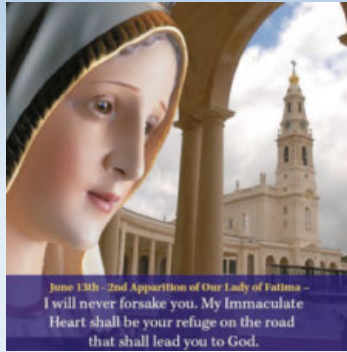
she leads us closer to her Son, the King of Kings. **This is scheduled for July 10th through July 14th from 5 pm to 8:30 pm.**
