

# Pastor's Letter: July 16, 2023

■15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus said to His disciples, "But blessed are your eyes, because they see, and your ears, because they hear."

A Christian Life is a Virtuous Life

The New Law of the New Testament, is the Law of Christ. The Law of Christ is not a common set of legal regulations. The demands and requirements of the Gospel go beyond strictly human possibilities.

Jesus answered, "Not all can accept [this] word, but only those to whom that is granted." (Matthew 19:11) Law of Christ is a gift, and it takes a Gift to follow it. This Gift is the grace of the Holy Spirit, which we have received at Baptism. The moment we were baptized, we were infused with the Holy Trinity, God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and we were infused with sanctifying grace and the theological virtues of faith, hope, and charity. The grace of God heals, restores and transforms the human heart. (By A. Rodriguez – Luno, and E. Colom, Chosen in Christ to Be Saints.)






