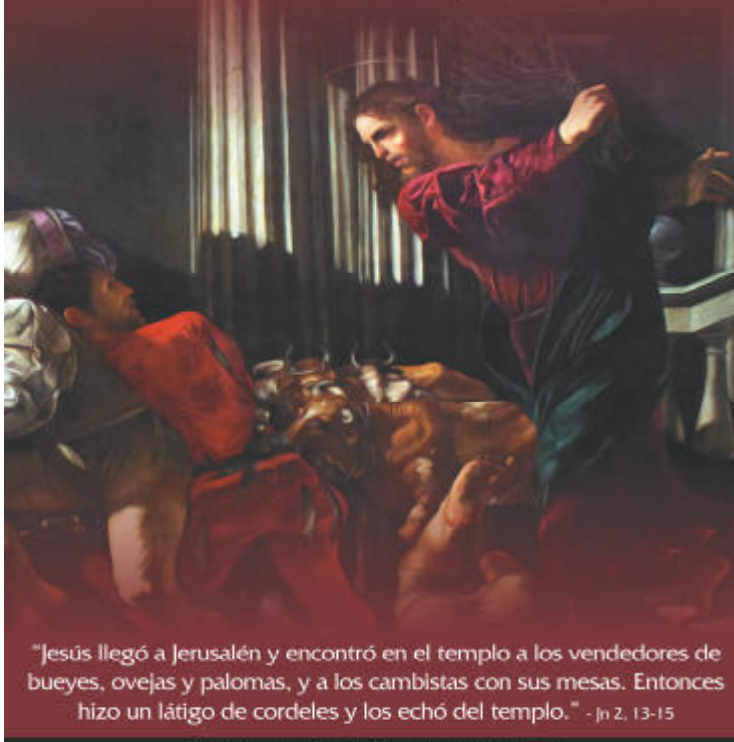

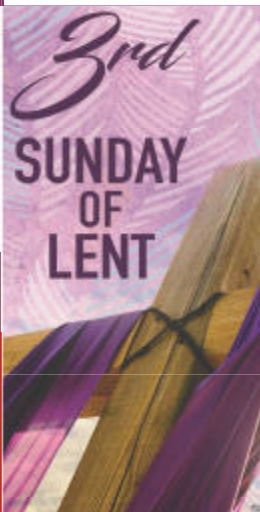
Inspiration of the Week

With our world in such constant turmoil and conflict, it makes such good sense to return to the simple directives given in the Ten Commandments.
