Epiphany Moments

Within the upcoming Sunday gospels throughout the next three weeks, we encounter epiphany moments where we experience God's revelation of His son, Jesus, present in our midst.

In today's Gospel for the Feast of the Epiphany, when the Church commemorates the coming of the Magi to visit the newborn king, we recognize that Christ came for all people.

On January 9th, the Baptism of the Lord, we hear in the gospel of Luke the proclamation of Jesus as God's beloved Son when "a voice came from heaven, 'You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased'". This revelation of Jesus as God's son came following Jesus' baptism in the Jordan River when He was in prayer and shows us the divinity of Christ.

Then, on January 16th, in a miraculous moment, Jesus' glory is revealed to us at the wedding at Cana when He changes water into wine.

God is wonderful in how He has given us different ways to recognize His Son, Jesus. Each of these moments helps us recognize Christ more fully.

Think about it.

Have you had an epiphany moment when you recognize the presence of Christ active within your life? What was your response? Did you hold that moment within your heart, pondering the great and mighty ways of God? Have you given testimony to your epiphany experience?

At OLPH, we have prayed the Missionary Disciple's Prayer for Evangelization. Within this prayer is a section that reads:

*"May the light of Christ within each of us
shine forth as a beacon of hope
that reaches those who are far from you,
drawing them back to You and your Church."*

When epiphany moments occur within our own lives, perhaps they are a way of challenging us to find ways to share those experiences by making connections and "becoming a beacon of hope" with others.

As you take time to pray, ask God to bless you with an "epiphany" moment – revealing to you a way to know, love, and serve our Lord in our parish community and throughout the world.

January 9, 2022
The Baptism of the Lord

First Reading: Isaiah 40: 1 - 5, 9 - 11

Responsorial Psalm: 29: 1- 2, 3 - 4, 9 - 10,

Going Deeper to Understand the Gospel

We have often witnessed the priest rolling up his sleeves in readiness for the ministry of the waters, the invitation of the children in the assembly to gather around the font, the reverent taking of the tiny, vulnerable scrap of humanity, and the holding up of him or her to the people into whose faith this child will be baptized. Then there is the triple immersion: in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Then another elevation, and this child of God is shown with a new christened identity to the assembly. There is always applause, always a smile on even the most bored faces, and a moment in which human and holy solidarity is felt, not only by the proud parents but also by the gathered local church.

Jesus joins us to Him in baptism. The trinity is on full display here, as Jesus, beginning His public ministry, is baptized *by the Holy Spirit*. Jesus receives His baptism through John, who, it is worth noting, is not God. Not only do we witness Jesus participating in an act that will become the cornerstone of the Christian faith, but we see it facilitated by a human who divinity is as precarious as our own.

It is through Jesus' humanity that we are saved. He is both fully human and fully divine, and in this scene, His humanity is on display for us. He receives the sacrament of baptism, and thus participates in the act that our own lives require to gain entry to heaven.
