

Dear Parishioners,



Prepare Yourself for Next Sunday's Mass

February 13, 2022 Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: Jeremiah 17: 5 - 8 Responsorial Psalm: 1: 1 - 2, 3, 4, 6

"Blessed are they who hope in the Lord."

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15: 12, 16 - 20

Gospel: Luke: 6: 17, 20 - 26


What are specific actions you can take to align yourself more fully with Jesus' call in the gospel?

Going Deeper to Understand the Gospel

Luke's Beatitudes are part of a sermon on the plain, not on a mountain as was Matthew's chosen setting. Luke's setting reflects Jesus' very down-to-earth ground rules for inclusion in the kingdom of God. Luke's Beatitudes are less spiritualized than Matthew's and, consequently, have more concrete social implications.

This is one of those times in the gospel when Jesus doesn't mince words, but gets right to the point. The kingdom of God belongs to the poor. The hungry will be satisfied. Those who are weeping will laugh. On the flip side, the rich have nothing left to receive, the full will be hungry, and those who are laughing will weep. This makes no sense in a world built around consuming for convenience, media impact, purchasing power, and the accumulation of wealth. What are we supposed to do with these words?

This week's gospel invites us to focus on the end game. Our purpose in this earthly life is to get to heaven, and bring as many people with us as possible. Do not let the physical and material goals of your career and family distract you from the ultimate goal. You are trying to love others, especially your family, in such a way that you condition your soul and theirs for heaven. That's what we are doing on Sunday. When we live with our eyes on heaven, this life becomes far more vibrant and satisfying. Shift your focus from earthy achievements to those of a love much greater.




