Guidelines for Fasting & Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fast and abstinence; all Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.

Abstinence - No meat (milk, eggs, & fish are fine)

Fast - eating only one normal size meal and two small meals, with no snacks.

ALL Catholics aged 14 and older are required to abstain from meat on the days of abstinence; those aged 18-59 are required to fast on the days of fasting *unless special medical conditions prevent them from doing so.*

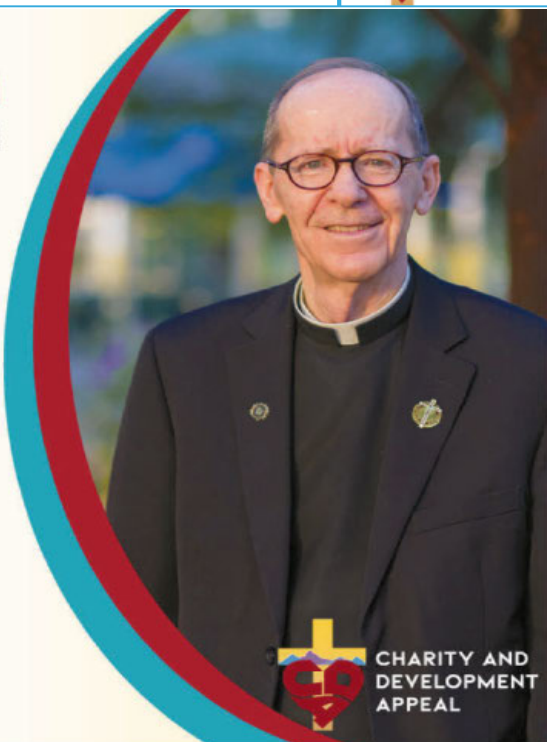

Prepare Yourself for Next Sunday's Mass

February 27, 2022
Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: Sirach: 27: 4 - 7

Responsorial Psalm: 92: 2 - 3, 13 - 14, 15 - 16

"Lord, it is good to give thanks to you."

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15: 54 - 58

Gospel: Luke: 6: 39 - 45

Are you preoccupied with the "splinter" in someone's eye these days? How can you turn that focus on yourself, someone you can actually change?

Going Deeper to Understand the Gospel

"A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, but an evil person out of a store of evil produces evil; for from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks."

The only thing you have to give is what you already have. This week's gospel has a lot of great one-liners, but if we take each on its own terms, there's a larger picture here that shows us we can't focus on others before we focus on bringing the best out of ourselves. You can't guide a blind person until you, yourself, can see. You can't point out someone else's faults until you have identified your own shortcomings. And you can't give people the good fruit of your own labor if you haven't made any good fruit. Last week's gospel was about how we treat others, and this week is about how we treat ourselves. In these words, Jesus is inviting us to be honest and assess ourselves with a critical eye.
