



## Guidelines for Fasting & Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fast and abstinence; all Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.

Abstinence - No meat (milk, eggs, & fish are fine)
Fast - eating only one normal size meal and two small meals, with no snacks.

ALL Catholics aged 14 and older are required to abstain from meat on the days of abstinence; those aged 18-59 are required to fast on the days of fasting unless special medical conditions prevent them from doing so.



# Prepare Yourself for Next Sunday's Mass

March 6, 2022 First Sunday of Lent

First Reading: Deuteronomy 26: 4 - 10

Responsorial Psalm: 91: 1 - 2, 10 - 11, 12 - 13, 14 - 15

"Be with me Lord when I am in trouble."

Second Reading: Romans 10: 8 - 13

Gospel: Luke: 4: 1 - 13

What is your biggest everyday temptation?
Why do you think this happens?
How do you usually deal with it?



Jesus is alone, hungry, poised at the edge of decision making before His Father and His own truth. With perfect timing, the tempter arrives with three attractive propositions: turn stones into bread; seize His power and glory over to the tempter; and throw Himself from the high point of the Jerusalem temple. The tempter assures Jesus that, since He is a privileged Son, God will certainly deliver Him from any human and airborne limitations by sending angels to catch Him and carry Him to safety.

This scene is grand in scope, but it gets at the heart of Jesus' story. Do you want food? Do you want power? Do you want safety? Jesus is fasting, so He is already hungry. He is the single most powerful human to ever walk the earth, and yet His life is that of an ethnic minority in an occupied region. Even though Jesus is God, He is still bound by the political and social systems of His own time, even as He is working to upend them. So to be met with these temptations of physical satisfaction and immediate power isn't something we should dismiss lightly Does Jesus send the devil away? Of course! But does the devil get the chance to make his case Yes. It should hearten us to know that Jesus, like all of us, went through the whole experience of temptation.

People of every generation must transplant the wilderness temptations into their own life and times, and the first contemporary temptation is to neglect the word of God and allow ourselves to be seduced by so many other words: texts, emails, mass media and the flood of digital information. However, the word of God feeds our deepest hungers. Our obedience to this Word is expressed in our attentive listening to its proclamation, especially in the Sunday liturgy, in our prayerful reading of Holy Scripture (*lectio divina*), and our efforts to make this Word "living and effective" from day to day.



# TALES FROM THE MISSION

#13 (A Parish for Scottsdale)

Our Lady of Perpetual Help church (The Old Adobe Mission) was already 15 years old, and under the care of several members of the Mexican barrio, when Bishop Daniel J. Gercke established the first parish in Scottsdale effective on October 8, 1948. The Parish of Our Lady of Perpetual Help became the largest parish, at that time, within the Diocese of Tucson. The boundaries were approximately 48<sup>th</sup> Street on the west to the eastern boundary of the Salt River-Pima Indian Reservation and McDowell Road in the south to the Maricopa County line to the north. A huge area with a small number of inhabitants. The assignment of the first pastor was announced; Father James Mulvihill from St. Catherine's in Phoenix; however, he did not arrive in Scottsdale until November 1949. Although the Mexican community knew that this day was coming, a feeling of despondency loomed over everyone, because, as often stated: "The people felt as if they had lost 'their' church." The times were changing, and the Mexican community had to cope with those changes. The appearance of the little church was well on its was to conforming to standard catholic church specifications. The floor had been laid in a coating of concrete, and a beautiful altar had been gifted to the church by Fr. Arthur Gramer, pastor of the All Saints church in Tucson. As you recall from an earlier episode, Fr, Gramer was a former pastor of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Tempe who brought the mass to our church on a missionary basis. Fr. Mulivill completed the transition by installing two side altars and communion rails that ran the length of the raised altar. Tensions eased in June 1950 when the iconic statue of Our Lady was received, a gift from Mrs. Guadalupe Dominguez, creating the feeling that everyone's wish had come true, the Holy Mother was present, all is well. Due to illness, Fr. Mulivill returned to Ireland in December 1952, later to be assigned to the Diocese of Cardiff, South Wales. By now the "Irish Invasion" was in full swing; there was a green hue on the horizon; you could hear the

footsteps nearing the southern boundary of Scottsdale. "From whence will he appear?" (To be continued....)
