

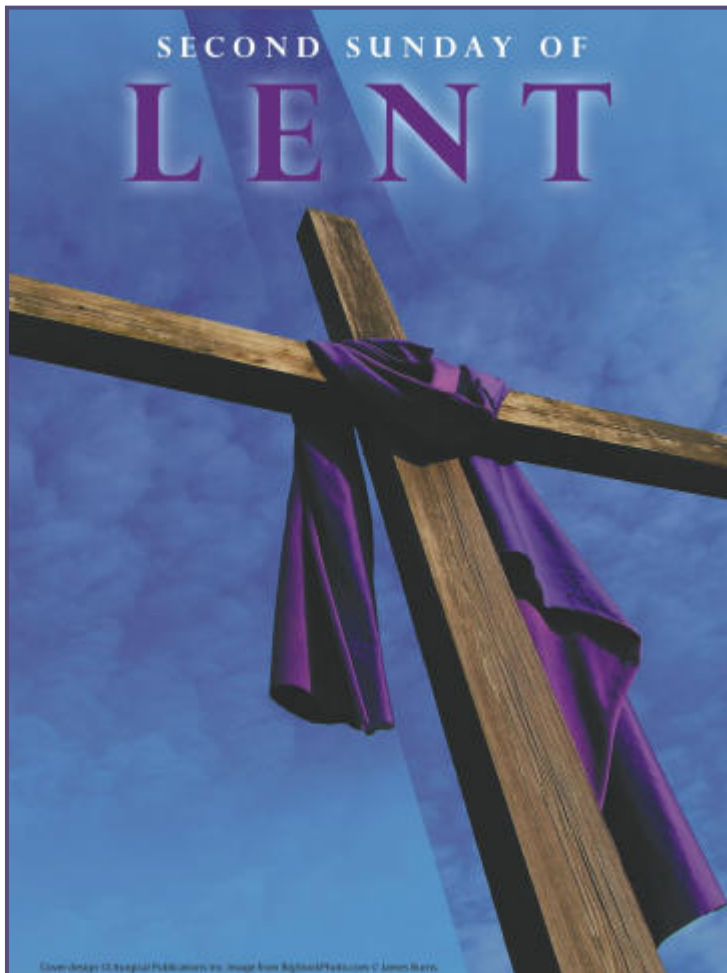

Holy Day Masses require signups for both the morning and evening Masses due to them reaching full capacity. Signup details are below.

The safety of parishioners at Mass is of great importance. If you are an individual attending Mass, please **sit, stand and kneel between the yellow tape marking on the pew and the closest end of the pew near you**. This allows for the appropriate physical distancing between households.

Sunday 11:00 AM Mass: Sign-ups Suspended.

Please check in with the greeter upon your arrival as seating will be assigned. This will allow the most people to attend Mass and maintain physical distancing between households.

E-Mail Confirmation Issues

Several people have reported not receiving their Mass Confirmation even though the email has been sent. Occasionally systems will block a specific IP address...not an email address...as it believes it to be spam or questionable in some way. Please note, email Mass requests received by 12:00 noon are usually confirmed that same day. If you email a request and don't receive a reply, please call the Parish Office by the Thursday deadline.

Weekend Masses (4:30 PM & 8:30 AM only) and Holy Days

We still require sign-ups.

Deadline for all weekend requests is Thursday at 12:00 PM.

Deadline for Holy Days is 12:00 PM the day before.

“When Setbacks are Setups for Comebacks”

If you’re wondering if you’ve been looking for happiness in the wrong places, then maybe you have been. Just ask former NBA player and coach Bill Hanzlik...

In 1977, the Denver Nuggets were looking for a head coach. Bill got the job....

[An ACL injury took out his best player for the season, and Hanzlik ended up playing five rookies.] “One stretch we lost 23 straight,” Bill admits. “It looked like we might have the worst record ever in the NBA.... Everyday I prayed, ‘God, what is your plan for me?’... I made it through the season. And I thought, ‘Okay, this could be a chance to move forward.’”

It wasn’t. Bill was fired....

Sometimes our setbacks push us to the big questions. What’s the point of it all? *Is there a point?*

Bill Hanzlik dove deeper into his faith and into service. He started a foundation with a mission “to prepare kids for the game of life.” ... They have helped almost eighteen thousand kids.

Now he wonders, “What if I got another contract extensions? What if I made more money? What if I had won a championship? That would have been really cool. But would it have fulfilled me? So many things don’t satisfy our lives.” ...

Bill became a man of service, because of his faith. He is one of the happiest men you’ll ever meet. If he had kept succeeding, that wouldn’t have been the case....

What is human existence all about? We want answers, real answers, to live a good life, a life of meaning.... The answers we’re looking for a there. But do you really want to know what they are?

Maybe the quest for answers can start by looking in the mirror.
