

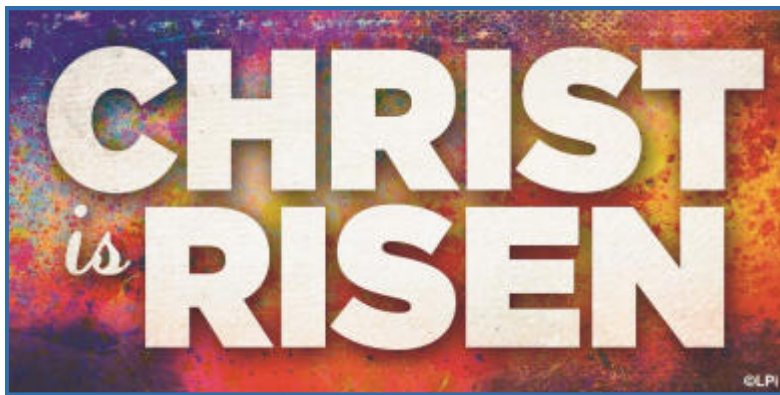

**FROM YOUR PASTOR & BROTHER IN CHRIST**

**HAPPY EASTER!  
CHRIST IS RISEN!!  
ALLELUIA!!!**

I'm writing this message on March 25, which is the Feast of the **A**nnunciation of the Lord.

And I'm eagerly awaiting the chance to exclaim "**A**lleluia" again at Mass, starting with the Easter Vigil.

It must be those two words that start with "A" that got me thinking at Mass this morning about being an "A-List Christian." I didn't want to distract myself by trying to remember the list right then and there during Mass. So I figured I'd look it up and reprint it. Here it is, from the homily earlier this year for the Feast of the Epiphany, January 3, which sure feels like a long time ago.

For Easter and the Easter Season and all the days of our lives, let's now think of "**A**-List" as meaning the "**A**lleluia-List." That is, attributes of folks striving to live in the Resurrection power and grace of Jesus Christ, our Risen Lord and Savior, Brother and Friend.

**ATTRIBUTES  
OF AN  
"ALLELUIA-LIST CHRISTIAN"**

- I. **Attention**—Be on the lookout daily, constantly, consistently for God's guidance and prompting in your life.
- II. **Activity**—Respond to God's guidance and prompting.
- III. **Anticipation of Adversity (free from Anxiety)**—Be soberly realistic about the challenges and the opposition that come with responding obediently and actively to God's will, especially from your own temptations toward resistance and/or indifference to God.
- IV. **Allness**—Strive to trust God, obey God, and please God with **all** aspects and areas and dimensions and facets of your life. (And, yes, "allness" is a real word!)
- V. **Alteration**—Be on the lookout for how you may need to alter, change, and adjust your plans and actions and choices and desires so that you're more and more the person God created you to be, doing the things God calls you to do... in the way(s) God wants you to do them.

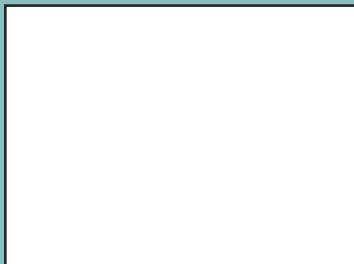
