FEBRUARY 6TH THE BUILDING BOUNDARIES CURRICULUM Catechists, of Kindergarten–5th grades, will teach this during regular class time. Parents of preschoolers can pick up materials in the Vanderzanden library that day or during Wanda's office hours. Even very young children can help keep themselves safe if they have the information they need. One of the best ways to help young children protect themselves against sexual abuse is to teach them about boundaries—what boundaries are, what to do if someone violates them, and how to tell a trusted adult when that happens. The "Called to Protect" program, which our Archdiocese has chosen for use in Faith Formation programs, helps prevent the abuse of children by giving them certain skills and facilitating conversations between children and adults about keeping safe. On the way to church to make his first confession, my nervous seven-year-old grandson asked me what he could expect.


"Confession is where you tell all the bad things you've done to the priest," I told him.
