



Human history reveals many periods where people lost a sense of God's transcendence. It may even be argued that human beings have been wandering and lost more than they have been at home and focused. Human nature being what it is, we struggle with who God really is — the God of our salvation history or the "gods" of human constructs. Relying on our own designs and pursuits, we forget that we really are meant to listen to One upon whom the Spirit of the Lord rests, Jesus Christ, and not to ourselves. That same history that reveals our fickleness and infidelity also reveals God's constancy and faithfulness. God always finds us.

As people wander and fumble to find their way, God is there bringing them back to holiness and giving them the assurance of His Presence. We have to allow God's Word, God's life, to touch us and change us. It can make us more flexible and attentive to the sacred in all facets of life so that every day is one that is Holy. Every day is a time when fulfillment is possible for one's soul. Jesus stood before those gathered in the synagogue as the fulfillment of words of promise that were echoed long ago. God doesn't forget. He always comes for us.

Now it is time to remember to go to God. Sometimes our lives are so confused and tangled that it is difficult to see the Word and hand of God. But when we realize, deep within, the depth of friendship God offers to us it really has the power to turn sadness to joy. The promise is fulfilled. Going frequently to God's Word, allowing ourselves to be enriched and rejuvenated, and pondering the certainly of God's fidelity and promise permanently transforms us. We will be more aware of the Sacred and the Holy and less invested in things that pull us away.



INSPIRATION OF THE WEEK

People can easily lose a sense of the sacred and transcendent. When we lose a sense of God's special Presence, we need to be brought back. Ezra brought people back to the word of God and they realized what they were missing. Jesus proclaims God's Word in the synagogue with true conviction and tells those gathered that He is the fulfillment of all that Isaiah taught. Even though people get lost, distracted, discouraged, and often journey down the wrong path, God's timeless law remains. When we allow ourselves to truly hear God's Word and act on it, that living word slowly, over time, changes us. It has the power to soften and mold us, creating within us a joyful spirit. We realize the truth in what God speaks and become open to God's love. Gradually and gently God leads us back where we belong. We discover again the sacred character of life and the wonder of God's Power. It is no wonder that Luke addresses his remarks to Theophilus. It is a name that means "beloved of God," a name that can be used by anyone who desires friendship with God.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT PROGRAM

The CMG Safe Haven online training has replaced VIRTUS.

The training consists of 3 vignette style training videos that are approximately 60 minutes. A criminal background check is included and must be completed.

The training is available in English and Spanish. We will no longer offer live training. All Safe Environment training will only be available online.

- All new employees and volunteers will complete the Safe Haven online training program instead of VIRTUS PGC training.
- -All individuals must complete the training and complete a background check prior to the start of employment and/or volunteer service.
- The 5 year anniversary date is still in place. Individuals who recently attended VIRTUS will not be due to complete refresher training until they have reached their 5 year anniversary date.
- -As the 5-year anniversary is reached, individuals will need to log into CMGConnect with their previous personal VIRTUS user id and 1234 as the password. Once you log into the CMGCONaccount, you will be able to change your password. If you do not remember your user id, you may contact the following:

Catholic Life Explained:

Question: Is it right to sue someone? Isn't it a way of getting revenge?

In some cases, it is the only way that people can get the help they need and deserve. However, frivolous lawsuits, or 'fishing for money' is not only unfair, but immoral as well. The law is there to protect people and making use of it when necessary is a good thing.



HONESTY IN OUR PRAYERS WITH GOD.

Not only is "honesty the best policy," it is the only policy acceptable to the Lord. In Hosea **6:1-3.** the Israelites prayed a poetic, prophetic prayer, of conversion and healing. According to some Christian writers, there is "hardly a more beautiful prayer in the Bible or in other religious traditions" than this prayer. Unfortunately, they prayed with insincerity. What was the Lord's reaction to this prayer? "What can I do with you?" {Hos 6:4}. The Lord observed that the Israelites' piety was: "like a morning cloud, like the dew that goes early away" (Hos 6:4). This tells us that if we are not honest in our prayers, we displease the Lord.

If we are not honest in our communication with the Lord, we are probably not honest about our relationship with Him. In the Parable of The Pharisee and The Tax Collector {Lk 18:9-14}, the Pharisee thought that he was right with God because he seemed better than other people and was faithful in his religious observances. However, the Pharisee was not being honest with God and with himself both in prayer about his relationship with the Lord. In **Lk 18:14,** Christ says, "Believe Me this man (the Tax Collector) went home from the Temple justified but the other (the Pharisee) did not. For everyone who exalts himself shall be humbled while he who humbles himself shall be exalted."

The questions therefore for us all are:

How honest am I in prayer?

Does my prayer life indicate that I really want God's name to be hallowed, His Kingdom to come, and His will to be done [see Mt 6:9-10]?

When I receive Jesus in Holy Communion, have I totally abandoned my life to Him so as to be in communion with Him? Do I live my prayers or merely "say my prayers"?

Father, I give my heart to You so I can pray to You!

Honesty is God's police for prayer, life, and love.

- Family history
- Lack of exercise
- Leg injury or trauma
- Prolonged sitting or standing
- Obesity or excess weight
- Current or previous pregnancies
- Smoking

If venous reflux is left untreated, it may worsen over time and develop into a more serious form of vein disease called chronic venous insufficiency, or CVI.2
