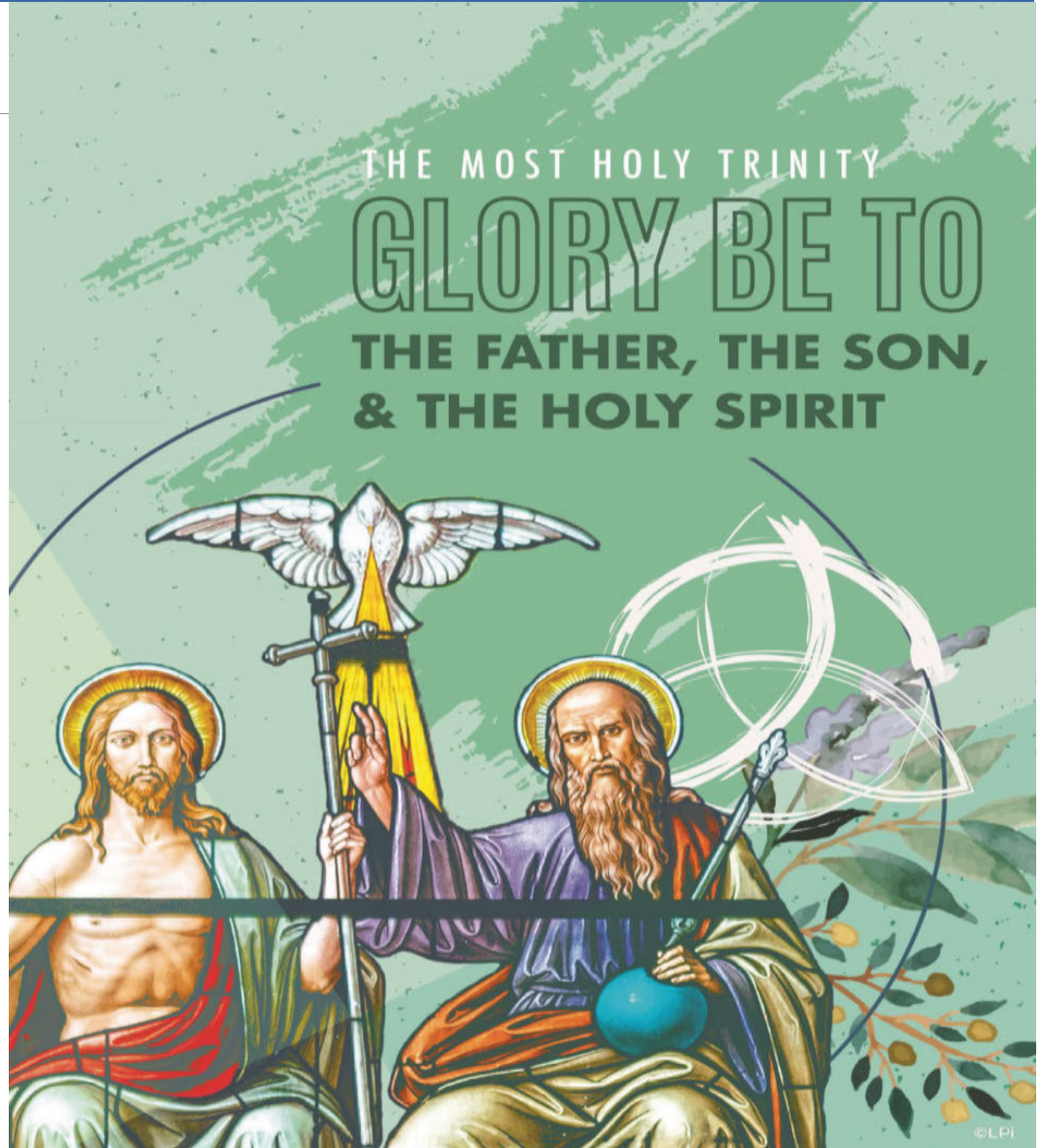

# REFLECTION

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

In creative celebration of the Most Holy Trinity, pray a rosary with creation. Find a quiet place outside or sit near a window. Contemplate the amazing Divine Gift that is before you. Admire it. Study it. Become one with it. Ask for the guidance of Brother St. Francis as you pray: “You, Holy Father, are King of Heaven and Earth. You are three in one, God above all gods. You are good, all good, and supreme good, Lord God, living and true. You are love. You are beauty. You are gentleness. You are joy. You are hope and happiness.” Admire the wonder and majesty of God in all that is around you. Ask for wisdom and understanding.

Begin each decade with the Our Father and conclude with the Glory Be.

**Decade one:** Contemplate God the Father. As you pray each bead with a Hail Mary, get lost in the grandeur of all that you see. Imagine the thousands and thousands of years of history that is before you. Envision a time when nothing existed. What is nothing? Lift your eyes, heart, and soul to the power and magnificence of the universe, its expanse and its endlessness. You are one with it all. God’s creative power.

**Decade two:** Contemplate God the Son. Behold the squirrels, birds, and critters all conducting life’s business. They have heartbeats just like yours. Praying each bead, become one with the incarnate divine life that flows through you and flows with the smallest of creatures. It is holy innocence and blessed life. Tenderness. Compassion, Mercy. Reverence. All want to be held, have a home, and be loved. God in all things. Emmanuel.

**Decade three:** Contemplate God the Holy Spirit. The changing of times and seasons happens often without notice. It is all within God’s care and guided. We all belong. Behold the living, dying, and rising to new life. You are one with all time from beginning into eternity.

**Decade Four:** Contemplate God as One.

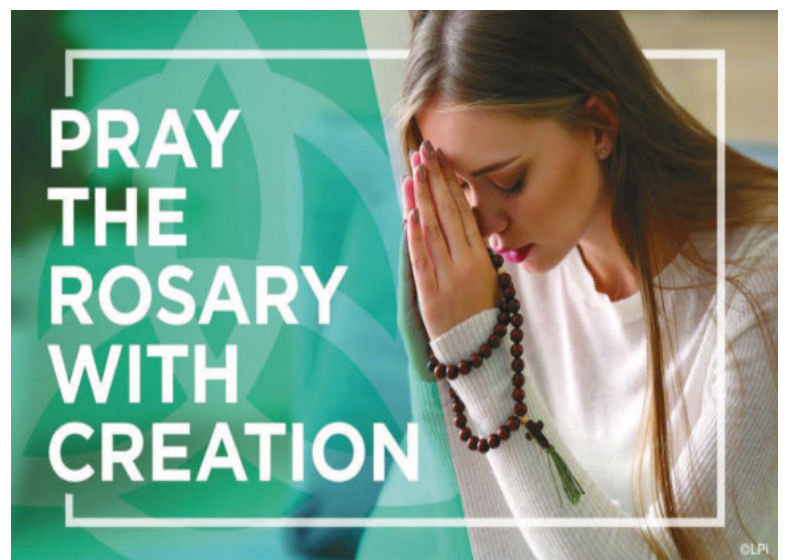
**Decade Five:** Contemplate God as three. All different while remaining One. The divine dance is being danced before you. Rest in what you see. Become what you see. We are all connected: God of the Holy Trinity, creation, our brothers and sisters, the animals, and the plants.

The rosary you have prayed celebrates the circle of connectedness and the intimate relationship we share with all things: a glimpse of the Trinity.

## INSPIRATION OF THE WEEK

Life can leave us feeling very distracted and detached. Perhaps this is why many people seek things that make them “feel good,” wrongly believing those things actually provide a sense of meaning and purpose. In truth, they are simply more distractions. When we discover real silence, we can realize that the stirrings and impulses in our hearts desiring connection, meaning, and purpose are really God desperately trying to pull us toward His Divine Heart. Once we submit to God’s pull, we are led to the beauty of God’s Presence. This holy presence carries us to the heights of mountains, the vastness of ocean depths, the beginning of things and their end, and the majesty of universal wonder. We meet the Father. Then, gently carried to the tenderness of compassion, love, mercy, and forgiveness we touch the innocence and vulnerability of life. We see the poor and those who are broken. We meet the Son. Finally, we are directed toward the seasons that change,

the ebb and flow of life, the inspirations that surprise, and the wonder, awe, and joy of life. We embrace the Holy Spirit.

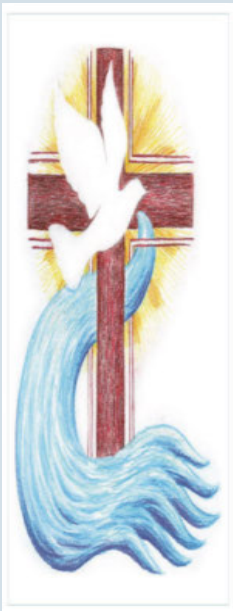

### WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained: Stem Cell Research

**Question:** Why is the Church against stem cell research, especially if it offers the possibility of cures for diseases like Alzheimer's and Parkinson's?

**Answer:** Like so many issues, the truth about stem cell research is more complicated than a few sound bites and vague promises of cures. For the Church, the problem is with embryonic stem cell research, not the research itself. The destruction of human life, even for a seemingly noble cause, is never acceptable. The ends cannot justify the means. Stem cells can be obtained in other ways, including from the placenta as well as from adults. So research is possible without the destruction of other life.

On the other hand, stem cell research shows much promise, but no concrete results. Some scientists also dispute what diseases might be cured by new discoveries. The research is still in its early stages. The question for our country is whether we should invest a lot of money in research now, looking for cures that will probably remain out of reach for most people, or should we invest that money in other programs with more immediate benefits, especially those that stress prevention and education. It is indeed a complex issue that requires close scrutiny and investigation before we jump to inaccurate conclusions or make decisions based on good, but misinformed, intentions.

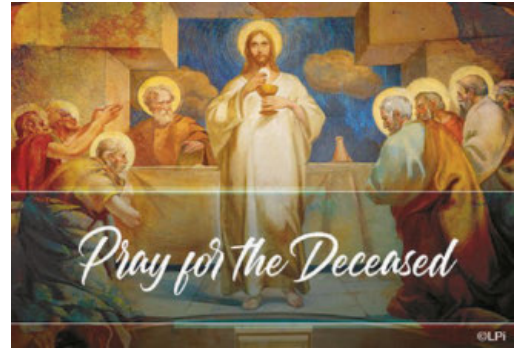
## NEW JERUSALEM CATHOLIC CHARISMATIC RENEWAL PRAYER GROUP

In **Luke 10:21**, Jesus says, **“I thank Thee, Father, Lord of Heaven and earth, that Thou hast hidden these things from the wise [learned] and understanding [clever] and revealed them to babies; yea, Father, for such was Thy gracious will.”**

The Bible says that **‘Jesus rejoiced in the Holy Spirit’** that His father had hidden certain things **“from the wise and learned.”** This does not necessarily mean that being learned is useless or harmful, but that our understanding is limited before God! **Proverbs 3:5** tells us to **“trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight {understanding}.”** Why? Because, it is only by the power of the Holy Spirit that we can know everything, even the depths of God **(1 Cor 2:10-11)**. Without the movement of the Holy Spirit in our lives, even the

most intelligent and educated people in the world are doomed to ignorance and even confusion, self-deception, and darkness. Christ, while physically on earth, told His Disciples in **Jn 14:26**, **“But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send you in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.”** For us, we need to cry out for the Holy Spirit to instruct us in everything, remind us of all that Jesus told us, and guide us to all truth, especially as He speaks through the teachings of the Church and the Bible. The Spirit will not only put ideas in our heads but words in our mouths to proclaim the goodness of God. For in the Spirit, we will hear the tiny, whispering sound of the Father’s voice, as in **Isaiah 30:21**, **“A voice shall sound in your ears: ‘This is the way; walk in it,’ when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left.”** Paul exhorts in **1Thes 5:19**, **“Do not quench the Spirit.”** As we give Him all of ourselves, He forever provides for us. **Heb 7:25** tells us, **“Consequently, He is able to save to the uttermost, those**

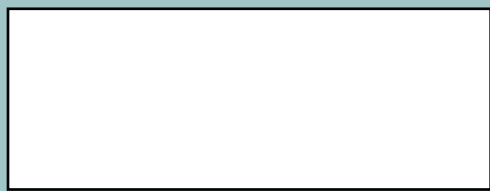
