REMINDERS DURING ADORATION BEFORE MASS

- 1) Keep necessary conversation quiet and to a minimum to respect others who may be in the midst of prayer or sacred silence.
- 2) If you are lector or altar server, please Don't approach the altar or ambo till after the Blessed Sacrament has been placed in the tabernacle.
- 3) Please remember to kneel as the priest transfers the Blessed Sacrament from the Altar to the tabernacle.

POR FAVOR RECUERDE QUE ANTES DE LA MISA DURANTE LA ADORACIÓN

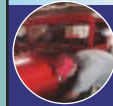
