Pastoral Reflections - from the desk of Fr. Andrew Carl Wisdom, O.P.

Dear St. Dominic Family,

Hearing his family members talking about the events of 9/11, a little boy asked his mother, "But why did those two planes fly into the buildings, Mommy? Didn't the pilots see where they were going?"

His mother shook her head and started to explain and then stopped, thought a moment, and said, "You have it right son, the pilots did not see where they were going." All those involved in causing the tragedy of 9/11 lost their vision a long time ago. People are not born this way. They were lost in more ways than one if they could inflict the kind of violent attack on innocent humanity whatever their political disagreements. Any of us can lose the vision and dignity of what it means to be human and the conscience built into that dignity when we cannot answer the question posed in our gospel today: "Who do you say that I am?"

This weekend's gospel question is not rhetorical or esoteric but sacred and practical in its implications for our everyday existence. To not know Jesus is to not know the beginning and end of our lives, our reason for being, and the One for whom we are destined. If we don't know the source and summit of our lives, how can we live them to their full potential? Let us remember those who died twenty years ago by remembering in whom we live now, confessing with conviction as Peter did, "You are the Christ!"

Reflexiones Pastorales - del escritorio del Andrew Carl Wisdom, O.P.

Querida familia de Santo Domingo,

Al escuchar a los miembros de su familia hablar sobre los acontecimientos del 11 de septiembre, un niño pequeño le preguntó a su madre: "¿Pero por qué esos dos aviones se estrellaron contra los edificios, mamá? ¿No vieron los pilotos por dónde iban?".

Su madre negó con la cabeza y empezó a explicar, pero luego se detuvo, pensó un momento y dijo: "Tienes razón hijo, los pilotos no vieron por dónde iban". Todos los implicados en causar la tragedia del 11-S perdieron la visión hace mucho tiempo. La gente no nace así. Estaban perdidos en más de un sentido si podían infligir ese tipo de ataque violento a la humanidad inocente, independientemente de sus desacuerdos políticos. Cualquiera de nosotros puede perder la visión y la dignidad de lo que significa ser humano y la conciencia incorporada a esa dignidad cuando no podemos responder a la pregunta planteada en nuestro evangelio de hoy: "¿Quién decís que soy yo?".

La pregunta del Evangelio de este fin de semana no es retórica ni esotérica, sino sagrada y práctica en sus implicaciones para nuestra existencia cotidiana. No conocer a Jesús es no conocer el principio y el fin de nuestras vidas, nuestra razón de ser y Aquel para quien estamos destinados. Si no conocemos el origen y la cumbre de nuestras vidas, ¿cómo podremos vivirlas en su plenitud? Recordemos a los que murieron hace veinte años recordando en quién vivimos ahora, confesando con convicción como Pedro: "¡Tú eres el Cristo!"
