Pastoral Reflections from the desk of our Pastor Fr. Luke Barder, O.P.

Happy "All Hallows Eve"!

Most know, but some may not, where we get the name "Halloween". It is actually from the term "All Hallows Eve", which is basically All Saints ("Hallows") Day Eve. On All Saints Day, we commemorate those we may not have known in this life, but are sure guides in living the Christian life. On All Souls Day, remember those closer to home, our deceased loved ones.

St. Dominic's has a long tradition of remembering our loved ones, especially through the month of November. At our All Souls Mass, we invite all those who celebrated their funeral at St. Dominic's in the past year. All are invited to do join us again on our special Mass, Tuesday, Nov. 2, at 7pm. It will be Bilingual.

This year, however, we are also introducing a special 3-day event which we are calling the COVID Memorial Week. The special pain we all feel from those lost to this pandemic is ever-present in our minds. And not only ours of St. Dominic's, but of the WHOLE community. Starting with our All Souls Mass, we will be opening up the Church to anyone and everyone, regardless of faith, to come into St. Dominic's and pray for any loved one they may wish to remember. They need not have died from COVID, of course.

The evenings of Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday (Nov. 3-5), the doors of the church will be opened from 6pm - 9pm, where people may enter, pray, light a candle, and place a picture of their beloved deceased around the church. We will keep these photos up until the beginning of Advent (Nov. 28).

I hope you join us, invite all your neighbors, co-workers, and friends to join us these nights.

En el Día de Todos los Santos, recordamos a los más cercanos, nuestros seres queridos fallecidos.

Santo Domingo tiene una larga tradición de recordar a nuestros seres queridos, especialmente durante el mes de noviembre. En nuestra Misa de Difuntos, invitamos a todos los que celebraron su funeral en St. Todos están invitados a unirse a nosotros de nuevo en nuestra misa especial, el martes 2 de noviembre, a las 7pm. 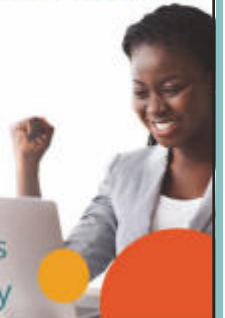
