
#### **Sharing the Gospel**



#### CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED I HAVE A FRIEND WHO RECEIVES COMMUNION. BUT WHO I KNOW FOR A FACT IS IN A STATE OF MORTAL SIN. SHOULD I TELL OUR PRIEST? IS IT MY RESPONSIBILITY TO SAY SOMETHING?

While we may always want to do what is best for our friends and family members, we have a responsibility to respect their privacy and their conscience. In its reflections Eighth on the Commandment ("You shall not bear false witness against neighbor"), the Catechism of the Catholic Church states. "Respect for the reputation of persons forbids every attitude and word likely to cause them unjust injury. [One] becomes guilt: -of rash judgment who, even tacitly, assumes as true, without sufficient foundation, the moral fault of a neighbor; -of

harms the reputation of others and gives occasion for false judgments appropriate concerning them" (no. 2477).




