They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. - Mt 2:10-11

Jesus is "a light for the nations." This marks a significant moment in salvation history. Up until the coming of the Lord, the covenant that God established was with the people of Israel. If you were not a part of the people of Israel, you were understood to be excluded from that covenant. In Jesus Christ, however, that covenantal love was extended and opened up to all the nations, the "gentiles."

This is essential to our understanding of our mission. If this covenantal love is meant for everyone, then we must offer that love to everyone. We have a duty to make sure that all people have an opportunity to receive that covenantal love and live in that relationship with God. 


