LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR, FR. JOHN PAUL LEWIS

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This coming week, about 25 of our children in the parish will be receiving a great gift! This Wednesday, we are celebrating First Reconciliation, and these children will receive, for the first time, the Sacramental forgiveness of their sins. It's a great time, I think, to reflect on this beautiful Sacrament, and give thanks to the Lord for this wonderful grace.

One of my favorite things I do as a priest (and I think most priests would say the same thing), is to hear Confessions. It is a very humbling experience to have the Lord work through me to forgive the sins of his people who come to receive that mercy. After hearing Confessions, I am always in awe of God's great love for us, that he would pour out such great mercy upon us to forgive every one of our sins. I want to encourage you all to take advantage of this Sacrament as often as you can. I go to Confession at least once a month, and I find that the longer I go without it, the harder it becomes to live the Christian life well. This is because there is real grace in Confession. God's love that he gives us is more than

just the forgiveness of sins, but strengthens us in our seeking to live the Christian life.

Don't worry about the priest judging you in Confession, or it changing your relationship with him. I can speak from my own personal experience that I forget, almost immediately, the things that people tell me in Confession. It is a particular grace that I think most priests receive to a certain extent, to make sure that Confession is a place of nothing but mercy. The Confessional is a place where we encounter the Lord in a wholly unique way. Let the Lord work in your life; come to Confession and receive that awesome gift.

Please pray for our children who will be receiving the Sacrament for the first time this week. Ask the Lord to pour his grace abundantly upon them, that they may always strive to grow close to him in holiness, and allow him to transform them into saints.




