

A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

My dear parish family,

HAPPY NEW YEAR!!! This weekend we begin an entirely new liturgical year with this First Sunday of Advent. This season of Advent is a time for us to focus on preparing to welcome the Prince of Peace...not only as He has come to us as an infant on that first Christmas a couple of thousand years ago, but also as He will come again in glory at the end of time. And, finally, during this Advent season we live in heightened expectation of His coming among us in all those ways—large and small—that he makes his approach to us in the here-and-now. We're not just looking forward to His coming during Advent; we're celebrating His presence, too.

If we're not careful and attentive, this could just be a few weeks when we once again get in touch with our Inner Grinch. Even during this time of pandemic, there is an aggressive commercialism and a crush of social commitments that could distract us from the main order of business: preparing once again to welcome Jesus into our hearts, our homes, and our world.

Probably all of us have different ways of celebrating this season, different practices that prepare us and our families for the biggest birthday bash on the planet. Nativity scenes need to be carefully taken out of their battered old boxes and set up (but of course with the Christ Child not placed in the manger until Christmas morning!). But here's one way in particular that all of us should be keeping centered on the SEASON and not on the SALES: the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Going to confession is an essential element in our preparations for welcoming Christ at Christmas! For the first time in quite a while we'll be having a Communal Penance Service on Monday, November 29th, at 7:00 p.m.

Once again: HAPPY NEW YEAR! Let's resolve to spend these weeks of the new liturgical year preparing for the coming of the Lord in an atmosphere of quiet joy and excitement!



Understanding the dangers of carbon monoxide

Carbon monoxide is an odorless, colorless gas that is often undetected. More than 400 people in the U.S. die every year from unintentional carbon monoxide poisoning, and thousands more are hospitalized. When gas builds up in enclosed spaces, people or animals who breathe it in can be poisoned. Consider installing a battery-operated carbon monoxide detector, and have your furnace, water heater, and other gas or coal-burning appliances serviced regularly, along with your chimney. 
