#### **Fourth Sunday of Lent March 15th, John 9:1-41**

Lord, you are of course "the light of the world." But you are also the light that illumines my heart and my life. Is there some corner of my heart, some part of my life, that is most in need of you and the light that you are for me?

#### **Monday of the Fourth Week of Lent March 16th, John 4:43-54**

That royal official believed-before-he-saw. He believed simply because you spoke. I want to have that kind of trust, that kind of confidence, in you.

During Lent, those preparing to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil celebrate three special rites called the Scrutinies. These prayers and rituals take place on the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Sundays of Lent during the 10:00AM Mass.

*Each Scrutiny is connected to powerful stories from the Gospel of John:*

- 3rd Sunday: The Woman at the Well (living water)
- **4th Sunday: The Man Born Blind (light of the world)**
- 5th Sunday: The Raising of Lazarus (new life)

The Scrutinies remind all of us that Lent is a time to examine our own hearts, turn away from sin and trust more deeply in Christ's saving love.


