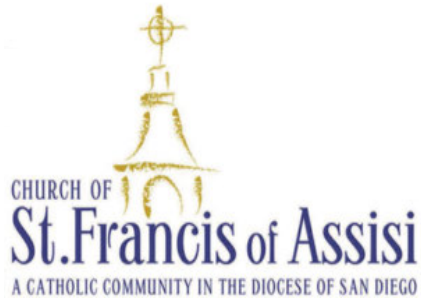

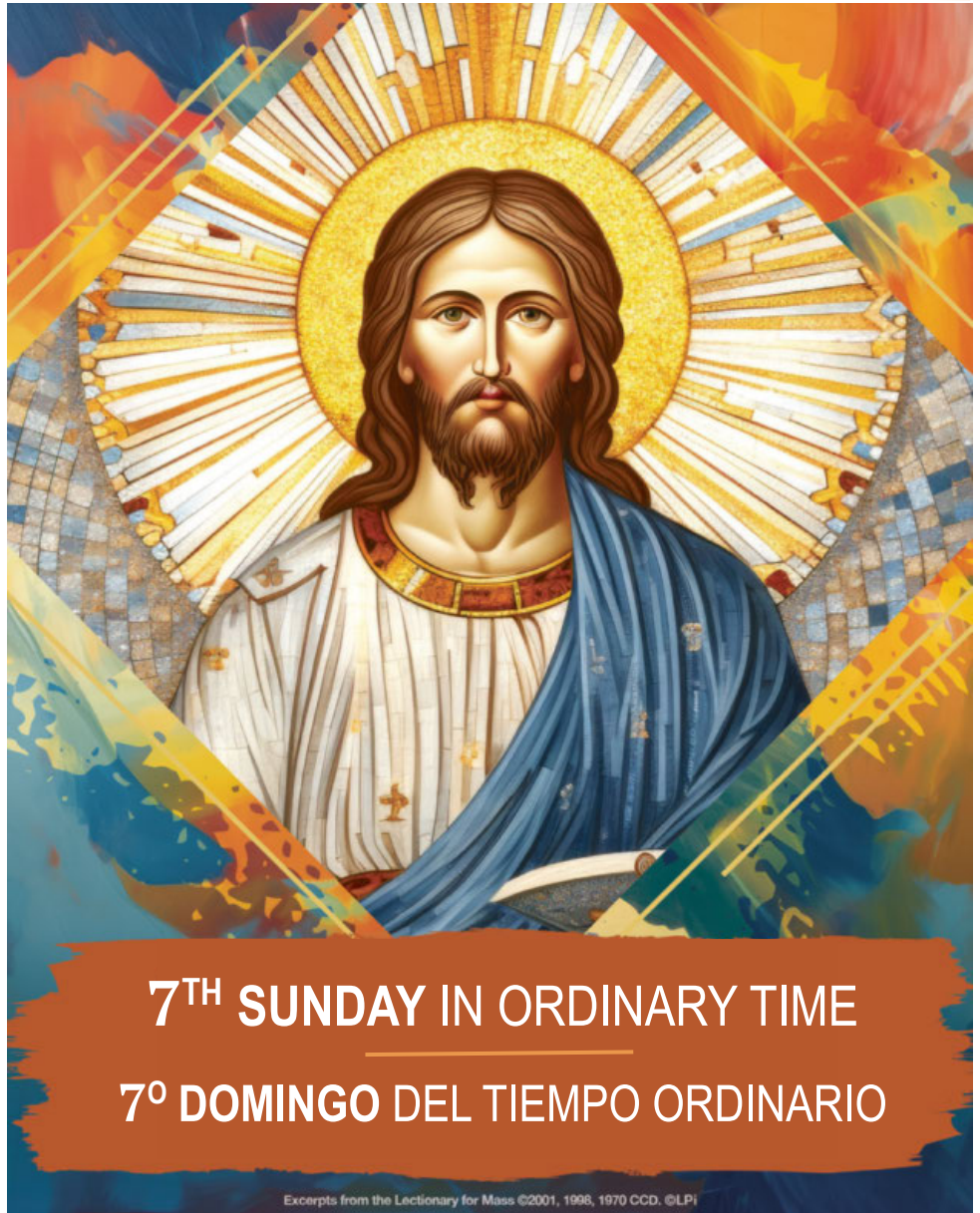

SUNDAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING

(1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23)

In those days, Saul went down to the desert of Ziph with three thousand picked men of Israel, to search for David in the desert of Ziph.

So David and Abishai went among Saul's soldiers by night and found Saul lying asleep within the barricade, with his spear thrust into the ground at his head and Abner and his men sleeping around him.

Abishai whispered to David: "God has delivered your enemy into your grasp this day.

Let me nail him to the ground with one thrust of the spear; I will not need a second thrust!"

But David said to Abishai, "Do not harm him, for who can lay hands on the LORD's anointed and remain unpunished?"

So David took the spear and the water jug from their place at Saul's head, and they got away without anyone's seeing or knowing or awakening.

All remained asleep, because the LORD had put them into a deep slumber.

Going across to an opposite slope, David stood on a remote hilltop at a great distance from Abner, son of Ner, and the troops.

He said: "Here is the king's spear.

Let an attendant come over to get it. The LORD will reward each man for his justice and faithfulness.

Today, though the LORD delivered you into my grasp, I would not harm the LORD's anointed."



PSALM (Ps 103)

R. The Lord is kind and merciful.



SECOND READING (1 Corinthians 15:45-49)

Brothers and sisters: It is written, *The first man, Adam, became a living being*, the last Adam a life-giving spirit.

But the spiritual was not first; rather the natural and then the spiritual. The first man was from the earth, earthly; the second man, from heaven.

As was the earthly one, so also are the earthly, and as is the heavenly one, so also are the heavenly.

Just as we have borne the image of the earthly one, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly one.



GOSPEL (Luke 6:27-38)

Jesus said to his disciples: "To you who hear I say, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.

To the person who strikes you on one cheek, offer the other one as well, and from the person who takes your cloak, do not withhold even your tunic.

Give to everyone who asks of you, and from the one who takes what is yours do not demand it back.

Do to others as you would have them do to you. For if you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? Even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? Even sinners do the same. If you lend money to those from whom you expect repayment, what credit is that to you?

Even sinners lend to sinners, and get back the same amount.

But rather, love your enemies and do good to them, and lend expecting nothing back; then your reward will be great and you will be children of the Most High, for he himself is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked.

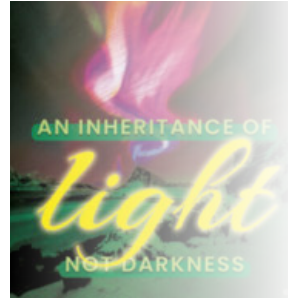
Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful. "Stop judging and you will not be judged.

Stop condemning and you will not be condemned.

Forgive and you will be forgiven. Give, and gifts will be given to you; a good measure, packed together, shaken down, and overflowing, will be poured into your lap. For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you."

GOSPEL MEDITATION

ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE



One of my favorite new singers/songwriters is Noah Kahan. I'm a little biased because, like me, he is originally from Vermont. In a fine song entitled "Stick Season," he sings of his hope to "cancel out the darkness I inherited from dad."

This lyric articulates his painful recognition of a

dark spiritual "inheritance" from his father, and his hope to be free of it. We all inherit some degree of evil from our earthly forebears. It's easy to feel doomed to repeat their darknesses.

But we're not so doomed, thank God. This week's Gospel proclaims this. Whatever good or bad we received from our parents, we have a more definitive and perfect inheritance in God. Jesus commands us, "Be merciful just as your Father is merciful" (Luke 6:36). We have a perfect Father in heaven and are destined to inherit and reflect that perfect and merciful love. We have an inheritance of light, not darkness, and thus a whole new possibility of magnanimous love. Like any inheritance, this is a free gift to us.

What are we destined to repeat? Not the darkness of our earthly parents. We are destined to be a reflection of God's life. Jesus liberates us from the inevitability of repeating whatever evils and imperfections are in our familial or cultural upbringings. It's time to claim that perfect inheritance.

LECTURAS DOMINICALES

PRIMERA LECTURA

(1 Samuel 26, 2. 7-9. 12-13. 22-23)

En aquellos días, Saúl se puso en camino con tres mil soldados israelitas, bajó al desierto de Zif en persecución de David y acampó en Jakilá.

David y Abisay fueron de noche al campamento enemigo y encontraron a Saúl durmiendo entre los carros; su lanza estaba clavada en tierra, junto a su cabecera, y en torno a él dormían Abner y su ejército. Abisay dijo entonces a David: "Dios te está poniendo al enemigo al alcance de tu mano. Deja que lo clave ahora en tierra con un solo golpe de su misma lanza. No hará falta repetirlo". Pero David replicó: "No lo mates. ¿Quién puede atentar contra el ungido del Señor y quedar sin pecado?"

Entonces cogió David la lanza y el jarro de agua de la cabecera de Saúl y se marchó con Abisay. Nadie los vio, nadie se enteró y nadie despertó; todos siguieron durmiendo, porque el Señor les había enviado un sueño profundo.

David cruzó de nuevo el valle y se detuvo en lo alto del monte, a gran distancia del campamento de Saúl. Desde ahí gritó: "Rey Saúl, aquí está tu lanza, manda a alguno de tus criados a recogerla. El Señor le dará a cada uno según su justicia y su lealtad, pues él te puso hoy en mis manos, pero yo no quise atentar contra el ungido del Señor".



SALMO (Ps 103)

R. El Señor es compasivo y misericordioso.



SEGUNDA LECTURA (1 Corintios 15, 45-49)

Hermanos: La Escritura dice que el primer hombre, Adán, fue un ser que tuvo vida; el último Adán es espíritu que da la vida. Sin embargo, no existe primero lo vivificado por el Espíritu, sino lo puramente humano; lo vivificado por el Espíritu viene después.

El primer hombre, hecho de tierra, es terreno; el segundo viene del cielo. Como fue el hombre terreno, así son los hombres terrenos; como es el hombre celestial, así serán los celestiales. Y del mismo modo que fuimos semejantes al hombre terreno, seremos también semejantes al hombre celestial.



EVANGELIO Lucas 6, 27-38)

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: "Amen a sus enemigos, hagan el bien a los que los aborrecen, bendigan a quienes los maldicen y oren por quienes los difaman. Al que te golpee en una mejilla, preséntale la otra; al que te quite el manto, déjalo llevarse también la túnica. Al que te pida, dale; y al que se lleve lo tuyo, no se lo reclames.

Traten a los demás como quieran que los traten a ustedes; porque si aman sólo a los que los aman, ¿qué hacen de extraordinario? También los pecadores aman a quienes los aman. Si hacen el bien sólo a los que les hacen el bien, ¿qué tiene de extraordinario? Lo mismo hacen los pecadores. Si prestan solamente cuando esperan cobrar, ¿qué hacen de extraordinario? También los pecadores prestan a otros pecadores, con la intención de cobrárselo después.

Ustedes, en cambio, amen a sus enemigos, hagan el bien y presten sin esperar recompensa. Así tendrán un gran premio y serán hijos del Altísimo, porque él es bueno hasta con los malos y los ingratos. Sean misericordiosos, como su Padre es misericordioso.

No juzguen y no serán juzgados; no condenen y no serán condenados; perdonen y serán perdonados. Den y se les dará: recibirán una medida buena, bien sacudida, apretada y rebosante en los pliegues de su túnica. Porque con la misma medida con que midan, serán medidos".

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

FOMENTANDO UNA COMPREENSIÓN MÁS PROFUNDA DE LAS ESCRITURAS



Hoy el Evangelio nos propone una catequesis de amor que obliga a estirar el corazón, para rendir al máximo al pedido de Jesús. Nos impulsa a pensar distinto, a interesarnos por los demás. Llama al perdón, a la nobleza, la humildad y, lo más importante, a saber,

compartir lo que poseemos materialmente y darse uno mismo. Es algo difícil lo que pide el Señor en este pasaje del Evangelio. Eso, de amar a los enemigos, hacer el bien a quien no nos quiere, de orar por los que nos persiguen, es fuera de serie, no se usa en la sociedad actual. Y agrega Jesús lo siguiente: "Traten a los demás como quieren que ellos les traten a ustedes" (Lucas 6:31). No se trata de que estemos siempre con la cabeza baja y humillados, mas bien se trata de luchar por la justicia, de no entrar en la violencia de tú me la haces, entonces, yo te respondo igual. "Porque si ustedes aman a los que los aman, ¿Qué merito tienen? Hasta los malos aman a los que los aman (Lucas 6:32). Por el contrario, bendecir a los amigos y enemigos es lo que nos hace dignos hijos e hijas de Dios. Pidamos el don de perdonar, de no ser vengativos, de tener un corazón de compasión, rebosante de ternura para hacer el bien. "Sean compasivos como es compasivo el Padre de ustedes" (Lucas 6:36). Ser semejantes al que siempre es bueno con nosotros. ¡Ese es el reto a cumplir!

Judgment and Love

"Oh, well. I'm going to hell anyway, right?"

I have a few family members and friends who are not practicing Catholics who say this to me from time to time. It's always spoken in a teasing manner, with a wink and a shoulder shrug, usually to explain away some sort of minor misbehavior they feel guilty about.

It saddens me that Christians have somehow gained this reputation as a people who judge, who condemn. I think in part it stems from a misunderstanding on the part of unchurched people (and lots of churched ones, too) regarding what constitutes "judging." It is absolutely not "judging" someone to disagree with a personal decision, whatever that decision may be, or to decline from participating in that decision. We all have functioning consciences; we are all supposed to discern the moral goodness of any action before we take it. But it is judging someone if we allow their decisions to impact how we treat them.

Today's Gospel is an invitation for us to consider how we engage with people who disagree with us — or maybe even actively dislike us. Much is said these days of the "culture wars." I certainly don't disagree that it can often feel like you're fighting a war when you're trying to live as the Church teaches.

The forces against you often seem overwhelming and nefarious.

And guess what? They are.

But we need to remember who the enemy really is. The enemy is not other children of God, even if they are children of God who are actively promoting ideas that are wrong. Perhaps these people are misguided and mistaken. Perhaps they are misled by the devil. Have we not all been misled by him at some point?

We must interact lovingly with people who think differently and live differently from us. The Christian life absolutely demands it.

No es en absoluto "juzgar" a alguien que no esté de acuerdo con una decisión personal, sea cual sea esa decisión, o que se niegue a participar en esa decisión. Todos tenemos conciencias funcionales; Se supone que todos debemos discernir la bondad moral de cualquier acción antes de llevarla a cabo. Pero si es juzgar a alguien si permitimos que sus decisiones afecten la forma en que lo tratamos.

El Evangelio de hoy es una invitación para que consideremos cómo nos relacionamos con las personas que no están de acuerdo con nosotros, o tal vez incluso a quien le desagradamos activamente. Mucho se habla en estos días de las "guerras culturales." Ciertamente no estoy en desacuerdo con que a menudo se puede sentir como si estuvieras peleando una guerra cuando estás tratando de vivir como la Iglesia enseña. Las fuerzas en tu contra a menudo parecen abrumadoras y nefastas. ¿Y adivina qué? Lo son.

Pero necesitamos recordar quién es realmente el enemigo. El enemigo no son los otros hijos de Dios, incluso si son hijos de Dios que están promoviendo activamente ideas que son incorrectas. Tal vez estas personas estén equivocadas y mal guiadas. Tal vez estén engañados por el diablo.

¿No hemos sido todos engañados por él en algún momento?

Debemos interactuar amorosamente con personas que piensan y viven de manera diferente a nosotros. La vida cristiana lo exige absolutamente.
