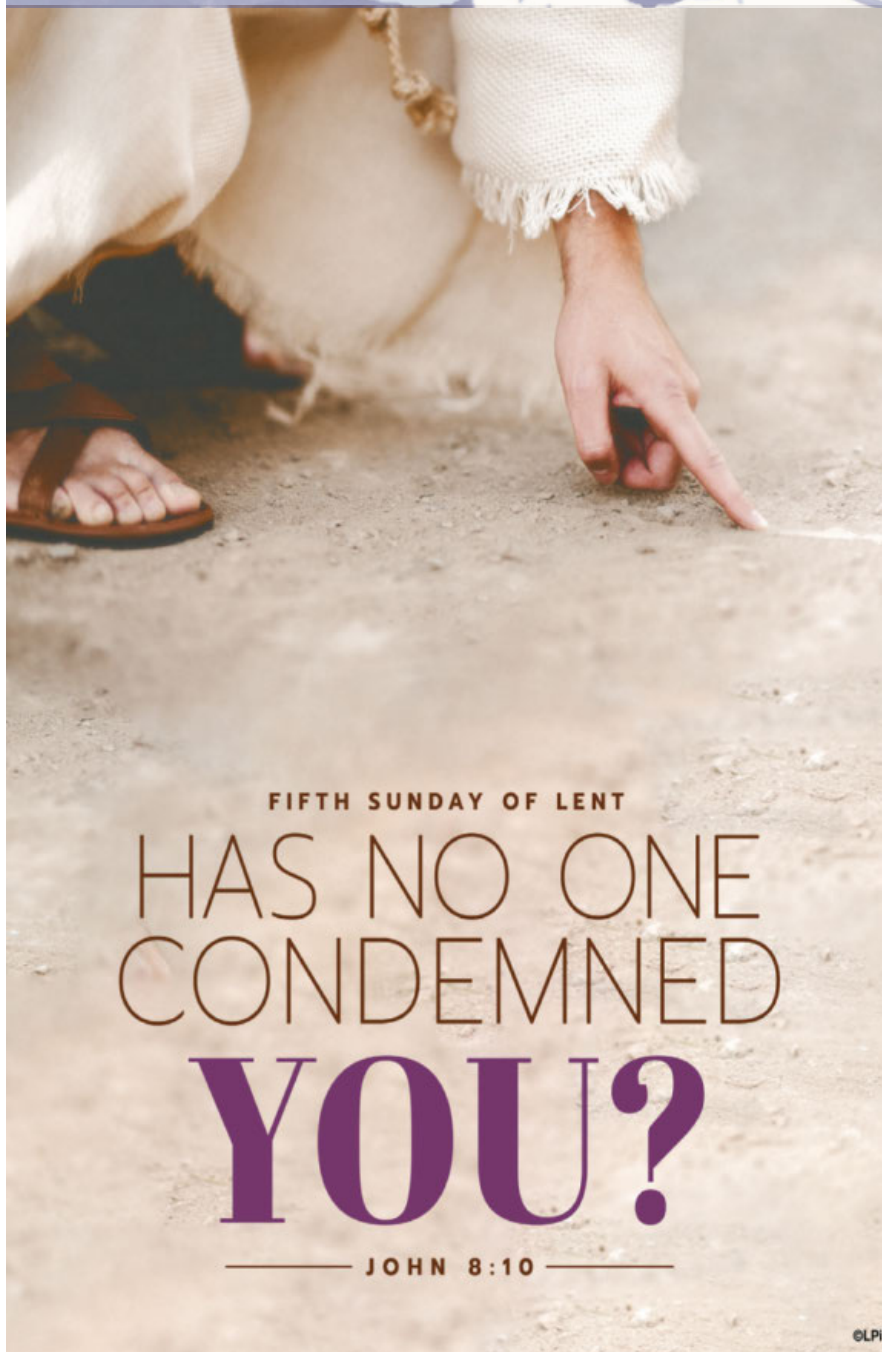

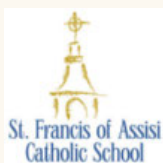

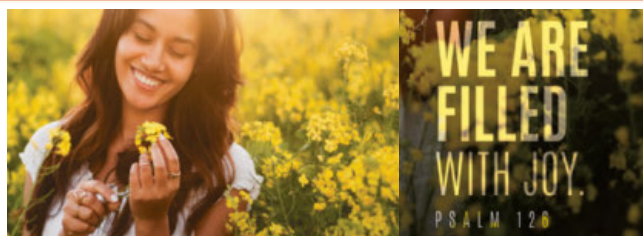

TODAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING Isaiah 43:16-21

Thus says the LORD, who opens a way in the sea and a path in the mighty waters, who leads out chariots and horsemen, a powerful army, till they lie prostrate together, never to rise, snuffed out and quenched like a wick.

Remember not the events of the past, the things of long ago consider not; see, I am doing something new!

Now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?

In the desert I make a way, in the wasteland, rivers.

Wild beasts honor me, jackals and ostriches, for I put water in the desert and rivers in the wasteland for my chosen people to drink, the people whom I formed for myself, that they might announce my praise.

PSALM Ps 126

The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy.

SECOND READING Philippians 3:8-14

Brothers and sisters: I consider everything as a loss because of the supreme good of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have accepted the loss of all things and I consider them so much rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having any righteousness of my own based on the law but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God, depending on faith to know him and the power of his resurrection and the sharing of his sufferings by being conformed to his death, if somehow I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

It is not that I have already taken hold of it or have already attained perfect maturity, but I continue my pursuit in hope that I may possess it, since I have indeed been taken possession of by Christ Jesus.

Brothers and sisters, I for my part do not consider myself to have taken possession.

Just one thing: forgetting what lies behind but straining forward to what lies ahead, I continue my pursuit toward the goal, the prize of God's upward calling, in Christ Jesus.

GOSPEL John 8:1-11

Jesus went to the Mount of Olives.

But early in the morning he arrived again in the temple area, and all the people started coming to him, and he sat down and taught them.

Then the scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery and made her stand in the middle.

They said to him, "Teacher, this woman was caught in the very act of committing adultery.

Now in the law, Moses commanded us to stone such women. So what do you say?"

They said this to test him, so that they could have some charge to bring against him.

Jesus bent down and began to write on the ground with his finger. But when they continued asking him, he straightened up and said to them, "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her."

Again he bent down and wrote on the ground. And in response, they went away one by one, beginning with the elders.

So he was left alone with the woman before him.

Then Jesus straightened up and said to her,

"Woman, where are they?

Has no one condemned you?" She replied, "No one, sir."

Then Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you.

Go, and from now on do not sin any more."



GOSPEL MEDITATION

"The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery and made her stand in the middle" (John 8:3).

Why do they make her stand in the middle?

Why not expose her on the periphery?

The reason is something that affects us practically every day.

The center is what stabilizes a community's identity. We humans tend to center ourselves around an accused and condemned victim — though we rarely admit it. This renews our fragile communities and our power as those who weaponize the accusation. This is effective because it is often a victim who represents something truly dangerous for the group. In this case, adultery stands for the breakdown of a community and those within it, because it forces questions like: who is my father? Whose child is this? Is this child one of us, or that of an outsider? The accusers place the adulteress in the center because their community, like most, is built around turning an enemy into a victim.

Once you understand this, you'll see it almost anywhere humans group together (families, politics, workplaces, sports, schools, etc.). The good news is Jesus exposes this dynamic by deftly pointing out the sin-infected hearts of everyone besides the woman. They all leave, symbolizing the breakdown of the old order, and she is **"left alone before him."** A new community has begun, structured around the merciful love of Christ.

What is in your center? What is in the center of our parish and family communities? Strive to center on Christ's forgiveness, and we experience the new, lasting community we call the Church.

LECTURAS DE HOY

PRIMERA LECTURA Isaías 43, 16-21

Esto dice el Señor, que abrió un camino en el mar
y un sendero en las aguas impetuosas,
el que hizo salir a la batalla

SEGUNDA LECTURA Filipenses 3, 8-14

Hermanos: Todo lo que era valioso para mí, lo consideré sin valor a causa de Cristo. Más aún pienso que nada vale la pena en comparación con el bien supremo, que consiste en conocer a Cristo Jesús, mi Señor, por cuyo amor he renunciado a todo, y todo lo considero como basura, con tal de ganar a Cristo y de estar unido a él, no porque haya obtenido la justificación que proviene de la ley, sino la que procede de la fe en Cristo Jesús, con la que Dios hace justos a los que creen.

Y todo esto, para conocer a Cristo, experimentar la fuerza de su resurrección, compartir sus sufrimientos y asemejarme a él en su muerte, con la esperanza de resucitar con él de entre los muertos.

No quiero decir que haya logrado ya ese ideal o que sea ya perfecto, pero me esfuerzo en conquistarlo, porque Cristo Jesús me ha conquistado. No, hermanos, considero que todavía no lo he logrado. Pero eso sí, olvido lo que he dejado atrás, y me lanzo hacia adelante, en busca de la meta y del trofeo al que Dios, por medio de Cristo Jesús, nos llama desde el cielo.

EVANGELIO Juan 8, 1-11

En aquel tiempo, Jesús se retiró al monte de los Olivos y al amanecer se presentó de nuevo en el templo, donde la multitud se le acercaba; y él, sentado entre ellos, les enseñaba.

Entonces los escribas y fariseos le llevaron a una mujer sorprendida en adulterio, y poniéndola frente a él, le dijeron: "Maestro, esta mujer ha sido sorprendida en flagrante adulterio. Moisés nos manda en la ley apedrear a estas mujeres. ¿Tú que dices?"

Le preguntaban esto para ponerle una trampa y poder acusarlo. Pero Jesús se agachó y se puso a escribir en el suelo con el dedo.

Como insistían en su pregunta, se incorporó y les dijo: "Aquel de ustedes que no tenga pecado, que le tire la primera piedra". Se volvió a agachar y siguió escribiendo en el suelo.

Al oír aquellas palabras, los acusadores comenzaron a escabullirse uno tras otro, empezando por los más viejos, hasta que dejaron solos a Jesús y a la mujer, que estaba de pie, junto a él.

Entonces Jesús se enderezó y le preguntó: "Mujer, ¿dónde están los que te acusaban? ¿Nadie te ha condenado?" Ella le contestó:

"Nadie, Señor". Y Jesús le dijo: "Tampoco yo te condeno. Vete y ya no vuelvas a pecar".



MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Estamos llegando al final de la Cuaresma. Se termina el Jueves Santo con la Misa de la Cena del Señor. "En la Cuaresma, la Iglesia renueva la llamada a la conversión. El hombre nuevo nace en el Bautismo. Dios nos hace sus hijos y nos incorpora a Cristo y a su iglesia. Del corazón del hombre renovado, según Dios, proceden los comportamientos buenos. Estamos llamados a abandonar los comportamientos del pecado y a fijar la mirada en lo esencial" (Papa Francisco).

¿Qué sería lo esencial? Lo primero sería buscar dentro de nosotros mismos para dar respuesta, comenzando con mis actos y los de los demás. A veces, somos tan duros para juzgar. Aplicamos la ley de la piedra sin piedad. Duros de corazón, difíciles para practicar el perdón. Sin embargo, Tú, Señor, me perdonas con la blandura de un Evangelio escrito en el suelo, es decir, en tierra blanda. Aprovechemos hoy para pedir a Jesús la enseñanza de la misericordia. Esa misma misericordia aplicada a la mujer sorprendida en adulterio. ¿Qué debió haber sentido aquella persona acusada a la pregunta de Jesús?

"Mujer, ¿dónde están? ¿Ninguno te ha condenado? Ella contestó: Ninguno, Señor. Y Jesús le dijo: Tampoco yo te condeno. Vete y en adelante no vuelvas a pecar" (Juan 8:10-11). Pues bien, el reto de la conversión es no volver a pecar. Es aprender día a día a ser buenos, con nosotros mismos y con los demás.

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LITURGICAL LIFE

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

The Allure of Being Right / It wasn't a real question.

"The law of Moses says we should stone her. What do you say?" the Pharisees asked Jesus as they brought the adulterous woman before him. But they weren't really asking. They didn't care what Jesus' answer was. They didn't ask his opinion because they wanted to know. They asked because they wanted to use his words against him. Righteousness, truth — that wasn't the goal. The goal was being right. And in the middle of the whole scene, dragged before Jesus, used as a literal prop in this staged drama, is a woman. A real flesh-and-blood woman.

I find myself wanting to know more about her. She had been "caught in the act," they claimed, but I wonder what that even means. With whom was this act committed, and what were the reasons for her participation in it? Was she coerced? Was she scared? Was she confused? Was it really a cut-and-dry, black-and-white situation of adultery, of lust, of making the wrong decision?

We will never know the answers to these questions, and it doesn't matter — it's not our business. God knows the answers. God knows the truth of the matter: what she did, what she chose, what she felt.

Because she wasn't a prop to Him. She was a person.

When God looks at us, he sees more than the worst decisions we've ever made.

I worry that we use one another as props even today, when we try like the Pharisees to illustrate "What is Right." We have a terrible tendency to see only decisions, and in doing so we dehumanize the people behind them.

Too often, we don't care about righteousness or truth.

We just care about being right.

RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

La fascinación de tener la razón / No fue una verdadera pregunta.

"La ley de Moisés manda que la apedreemos. ¿Qué dices tú?", preguntaron los fariseos a Jesús mientras le llevaban a la mujer adúltera a sus pies. Pero, ellos en realidad, no le estaban haciendo una pregunta a Jesús, ni les importaba cuál sería la respuesta de Jesús, no le preguntaron su opinión porque quisieran saber. Los fariseos le preguntaron pues querían usar las palabras de Jesús en su contra.

La justicia y la verdad no eran el propósito. Solamente querían dejar claro que ellos tenían razón.

En medio de toda esta escena, arrastrada delante de Jesús, utilizada como una verdadera protagonista en este drama escenificado, está una mujer. Una mujer en verdad, de carne y hueso.

Me encuentro personalmente queriendo saber más acerca de ella. Los fariseos aseguraron que la "habían encontrado en el acto", pero me pregunto qué significa eso. ¿Con quién se cometió este acto y los motivos por los cuales ella fue parte de eso? ¿Acaso la obligaron? ¿Tenía ella miedo? ¿Estaba confundida? ¿En realidad fue una situación a secas, claramente de adulterio, un acto de lujuria, de tomar la peor decisión?

Nunca sabremos las respuestas a esas preguntas, y no importa; no es asunto nuestro. Dios sabe las respuestas. Dios sabe la verdad de todo el asunto: lo que ella hizo, lo que decidió, qué sintió. Porque para Jesús, ella no era una actriz, sino que ella era una persona.

Cuando Dios nos ve, Él ve algo más allá de las peores decisiones que alguna vez hemos tomado.

Me preocupa que nosotros no usemos entre sí como protagonistas aún hoy en día, cuando intentamos, igual que los fariseos, demostrar "Lo que es correcto". Tenemos una tendencia terrible a ver únicamente las decisiones, y al hacer eso deshumanizamos a las personas que toman esas decisiones.

Muy a menudo, no nos importa la justicia o la verdad. Solo queremos tener la razón.

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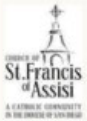

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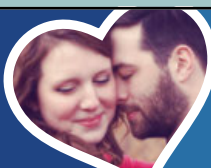
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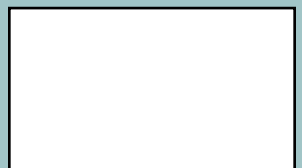
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
