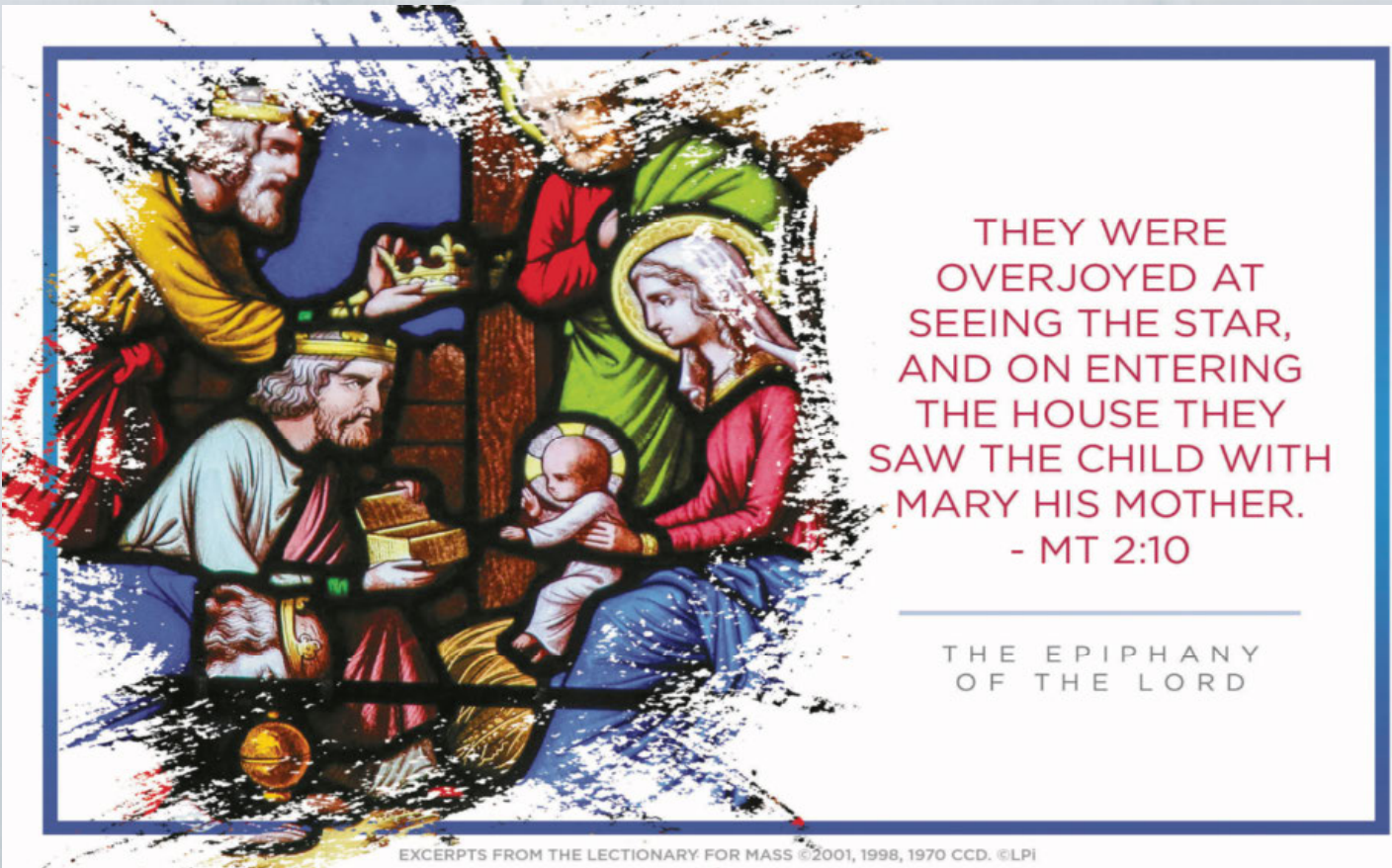

Donated calendars can be dropped off at the Parish Office for collection by the end of January.

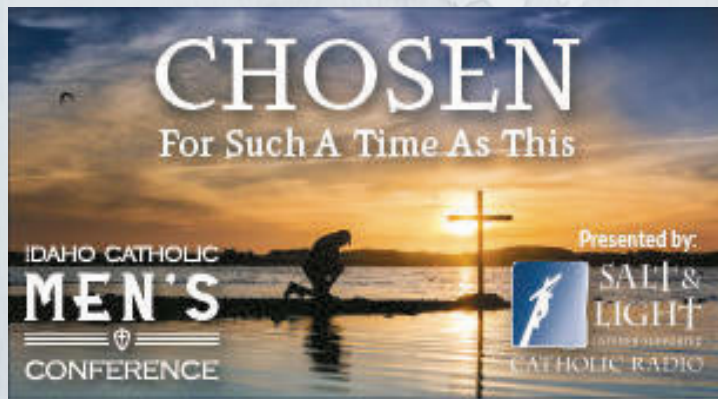
TORNADO RELIEF EFFORTS

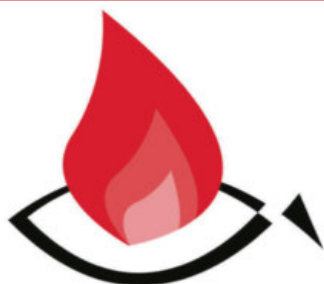
