The Sign of the Cross is made by using your right hand to touch your forehead, then the middle of the breast, the left shoulder and finally the right shoulder. As you do this, say, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." We begin and end our prayers with the Sign of the Cross. This prayer began at Calvary when Christ died for us on the cross. The early Christians often traced a small cross on their foreheads as a sign of faith. This same sign reaffirms our faith.


