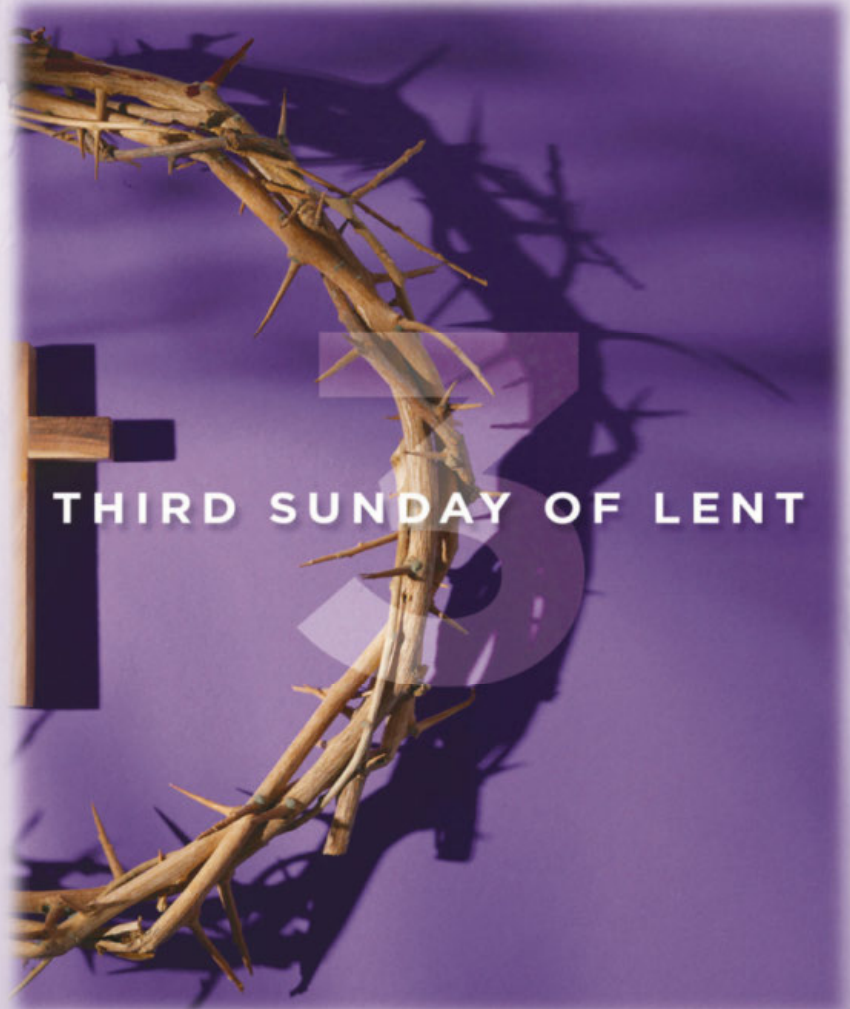

Why Do Catholics Do That?

Why do Catholics fast and abstain from meat during Lent?

Fasting is a spiritual discipline by which food is given up for a defined period.

There are only two fast days required in the Western Church: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast on these days. Fasting as explained by the U.S. bishops means partaking of only one full meal. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at the other two mealtimes.

What does abstinence mean?

The law of abstinence requires a Catholic 14 years of age and older to abstain from eating meat on Fridays in honor of the Passion of Jesus on Good Friday. Meat is considered to be the flesh and organs of mammals and fowl. All Catholics 14 years old and older should abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.





BISHOP KELLY HIGH SCHOOL – ATTENTION PARENTS:

Please note the following rules for students from all Treasure Valley Parishes who attend Bishop Kelly High School.

All supporting parishes follow the same guidelines which need to be met to qualify for the tuition support of the parish.

1. You must be actively registered as a family at Holy Apostles by no later than June 30th.
2. The family must be active in parish life by sharing their time or talent and treasure. Please note, the pastor will verify registration and participation in their parish. They must approve the tuition support payment for each student, or the tuition will be at the regular rate.
3. Each family must complete a Parish Support Application for each student attending Bishop Kelly and submit to the parish office before the start of the new school year. You MUST submit a Parish Support Application each year that your child attends Bishop Kelly. This form is included in the BK Registration packet and is also available on the BK website.

Each September Bishop Kelly sends us a list of the students who have listed Holy Apostles as their parish. We will verify the name and activity level for each family. Please take the time to introduce yourself to Fr. Vitalis and let him be able to put a face to the name before this list arrives.

During the last couple of years, we have given a lot of grace to families due to COVID restrictions. This year we will require that all BK families receiving the parish subsidy follow the above rules. If there are any extenuating circumstances, please contact the office as soon as possible.

Remember, parishioner registration involves participation.

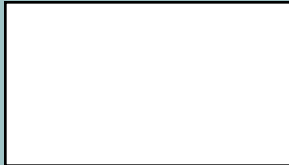

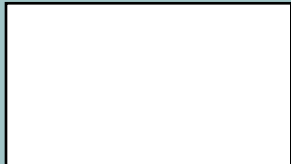
