



Why Do Catholics Do That?

How to Make a Good Confession:

1-Examine your conscience as you wait for your turn at the Confessional. If you think your confession will last a great deal of time (more than 10 minutes) it is wise to schedule a private appointment.

2-Enter the Confessional and choose either face-to-face or anonymous. The priest will begin

with the Sign of the Cross.

3-Tell the priest the mortal sins you have committed since your last confession. Venial sins do not have to be confessed, but you may do so if you desire. You do not have to go into detail unless the priest feels it is necessary. He will briefly discuss the effects of your sins and offer advice on leading a better Christian life.
4-The priest will give you a penance to perform (usually a prayer or good deed) and may ask you to say the Act of Contrition.

5-Finally, he will absolve you of your sins through a prayer.

6-As soon as possible, complete your penance and rejoice in the fact that your sins have been forgiven.


