





# **BISHOP KELLY HIGH SCHOOL –**



Please note the following rules for students from all Treasure Valley Parishes who attend Bishop Kelly High School.

All supporting parishes follow the same guidelines which need to be met to qualify for the tuition support of the parish.

1. You must be actively registered as a family at Holy Apostles by no later than June 30th.

2. The family must be active in parish life by sharing their time or talent and treasure. Please note, the pastor will verify registration and participation in their parish. They must approve the tuition support payment for each student, or the tuition will be at the regular rate.

3. Each family must complete a Parish Support Application for each student attending Bishop Kelly and submit to the parish office before the start of the new school year. You MUST submit a Parish Support Application each year that your child attends Bishop Kelly. This form is included in the BK Registration packet and is also available on the BK website.

### <u>New Software System:</u>

A Notice from Lisa Lawrence our Bookkeeper: As most of you know, last August we launched WeGather, a new parish software system which replaced PowerChurch for our family registry, and WeShare for our online giving. For several reasons, this software will no longer be supported by the developer. Due to this change we will be migrating to ParishSoft, a long standing and well-developed church software system. The migration will begin on Wednesday, April 20th and will be up and live for us in about 10 days. After the close of business on April 19th, you will no longer be able to log in to your parishioner portal or access your Online Giving on WeGather. Online Giving will not be migrating over until June. If you have a recurring donation, it will continue as normal and then your donations will automatically transfer to the new system. After April 19, if you need to make any changes to an existing recurring donation or would like to process a one-time donation, you will need to contact the parish office.


