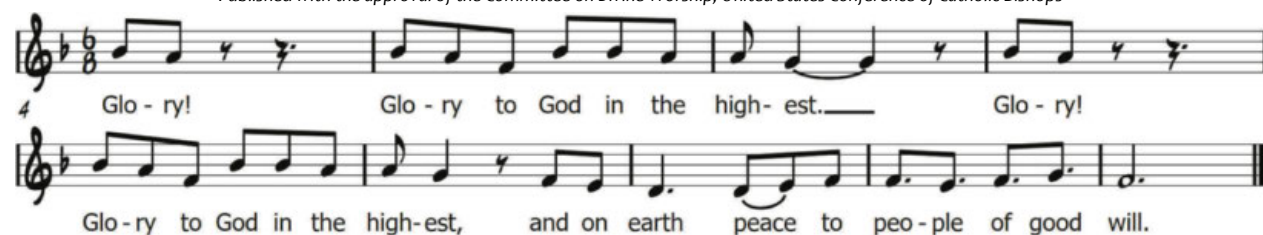

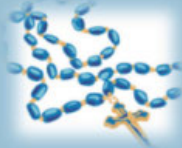

It's easy not to notice. You come to Mass, you pray, you sing, you hear God's Word, you listen to the priest or deacon's reflections on that Word, you bow your head for the prayers of the faithful, you profess your faith and then you sit down. The ushers start passing the baskets so we can offer something of ourselves to support the work of the Church and THEN some people walk down the aisle and give the deacon bread, wine and the prayer book. Do you usually miss seeing that last event?

Those people carrying the bread, wine and prayers to the altar represent all of us present at Mass and our desire that God turn that ordinary bread and wine into the very Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. We offer these simple gifts trusting that God will turn them into The Gift that will be our spiritual food. This beautiful moment at Mass is part of the transition from the Liturgy of the Word to the Liturgy of the Eucharist and you can have a part in it!

If you would like to carry the gifts to the altar all you have to do is talk to the Usher Coordinator when you arrive at Mass. We need a minimum of two people who are able to walk and carry things at the same time. Whole families are welcome and encouraged to participate. 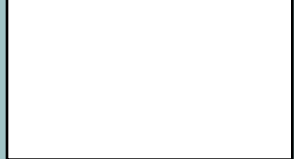

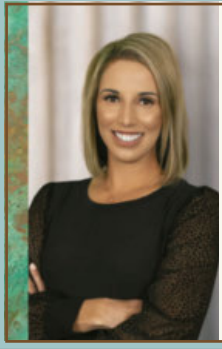
