LET US REMAIN FOCUSED

I came across a passage by Alexis de Tocqueville, where he argues that political liberty can be preserved in a republic only when the people of that republic are taught by religion to be virtuous. Although Tocqueville lived in the 19th century, the idea that religion equals a little more than morality still holds in the mind of some people today.

While, back in the day, Tocqueville appreciated that churches formed people in virtue, I sense that the younger generations of adults today see moral formation as a wagging finger and a scowl that they want to avoid, especially when church leadership, tainted by epitomes of evil, has lost much of its moral authority.

Our Young Adult Professionals group recently finished reading together St. Paul's first letter to the Thessalonians. While St. Paul does write about morality, that's not at the center of his message. St. Paul writes mainly about having been forgiven in Christ, and about rejoicing in the midst of trials and difficulties. For St. Paul, living a good life is just the consequence of a joyful people convinced that they have been reconciled with God in Christ.

During these trying times when our bishops, our president, and a nominee to the supreme court are being scrutinized for alleged moral failings (and they should be scrutinized and systemic reform needs to happen), let us encourage each other, and keep in mind that our faith is not in mere human beings, but in Jesus Christ who has died for us and is risen from the dead.

La Importancia del Contexto Social y Cultural

La invitación de Jesús en el evangelio de hoy a aquellos que quieran ser los primeros, a que sean los últimos, nos invita a buscar ser los primeros en servir, y los últimos en ser servidos.

Esta invitación nos invita a reconsiderar lo que implica servir al Señor. Si Dios Hijo se rebajó a nuestra condición humana, ¿qué sentido tiene buscar ser los primeros, si Dios mismo escogió nacer en la pobreza?

Las palabras de Jesús hoy día nos invitan entonces a reconsiderar cómo buscamos que nos vean o nos traten los demás, especialmente si tenemos una posición de servidores.

Los discípulos fueron a quienes primero les llegaron las palabras de hoy, y el con suma paciencia les enseñaba, por medio de obras y palabras.

La invitación de hoy llega primero a unos discípulos en una cultura en la que los honores eran muy importantes.

Y Jesús nos enseña que seguirlo no es solamente una experiencia espiritual interna, como a veces queremos reducir la religión hoy día, sino una respuesta a un llamado, en el contexto en donde nos encontramos.

La conversión entonces no es tanto un evento repentino y dramático que le sucede a una persona, sino mucho más.

Más que una ruptura con el pasado, aunque a veces eso lo implique, la conversión es un proceso de integración de todos los aspectos de la vida, hacia una orientación a Cristo como nuestro único Señor.

Hagámonos esta pregunta: ¿Qué ámbitos de nuestra vida, por ejemplo, en lo social, en lo económico, en lo emocional, puede Cristo reinar de manera plena? y, ¿Qué cambios implicaría para mí, y para mi familia? La conversión religiosa no puede ser aislada de sus contextos sociales, económicos y políticos, para ser realmente una verdadera conversión.

Cuando Jesús le hablaba a los discípulos, les hablaba no solamente como individuos, sino como parte de una cultura judía, y miembros de una sociedad oprimida, con sus valores y sus defectos.
