The Journey of Their Lives

Thousands of Central American migrants are trekking a perilous journey across Mexico and toward the U. S. border. As of Tuesday, October 23rd, the United Nations estimated that the caravan comprises some 7,200 people.

Depending on which news you read, you will either find heart wrenching stories of families escaping murderous gangs, or you will find a story of someone who was deported for breaking a law and is seeking re-entrance into the United States.

While the government has a duty to safeguard national security and pursue the common good of its own citizens, as Christians we recognize that all human beings are made in the image of God, and that those of us who have more, have a responsibility to help the poor.

Rather than pitting national security against the plight of suffering people, I think the Gospel and Catholic Social Teaching would steer us away from simplistic answers, and into prayerful and honest reflection.

Avoiding either/or type of thinking remains a challenge in our highly divisive times. I believe both things can happen: checking who enters into the country to screen out criminals and thus safeguard national security, and allowing legal entrance to a number of those who would long to live according to American ideals and values.
