## Gratitude And Generosity

This Thursday evening we might be expressing gratitude not only around the table of the altar, like we do at every Mass, but around a dining room table of someone's home. I will be up in the Bay Area celebrating Thanksgiving with my parents, sister, and an aunt and her husband visiting from Colombia.

I have much for which to be grateful. As Administrator at Saint Patrick's, I am grateful for the generosity of many of you. Earlier today, a parishioner gave me a large check for repairing the stove and hood system in the kitchen of the Parish Hall. A couple of days ago, someone heard about the financial need for scholarships at our School, and someone donated \$10,000 for scholarships. About two weeks ago, another parishioner gave me \$2,000 toward the making of new doors with windows for the confessional and the sacristy.

Our School is in great need of financial assistance and they are looking for more donors who can sponsor our students, as well as the air conditioning project. The church also has various maintenance and repair projects. Let us know if you would like to give toward the school fund, or toward a specific parish project.

A third way of giving is by helping us set up an endowment for formation and evangelization programs through the Catholic Community Foundation. In order to set up the endowment, we would need a minimum of \$5,000 in new donations (could be cash or other kinds of assets) designated for the endowment. An anonymous donor has pledged to match this initial \$5,000 if we receive the funds by December 31st, 2018.
