You might remember how I had mentioned some months ago about a small group program called Be My Witness, designed for parishes by Renew International, and which the Diocese had purchased the licensing for us to use it for 2 years. Be My Witness begins with a small core team for one year, and then the second year it grows into other small groups. I asked Fr. Phil to lead the program, and he decided to use content from it, but to adapt it with an Augustinian spirituality spin. He has named it *Amici*, which means friends in Latin, in honor of the fact that Latin was the language of St Augustine, and friends were a big part of his life. Thank you to the parishioners who accepted the invitation to be part of the pilot group.

El mensaje del Profeta Amós

El domingo pasado, al igual que hoy día, escuchamos la primera lectura tomada del profeta Amós. Amos cultivaba higos y también tenía ovejas en su rancho, cuando el Señor lo llamó y le dio la misión de cruzar la frontera que estaba separaba su patria con el reino del norte. En esa época había dos reinos que estaban en alianza con Dios: el reino de Israel en el norte, y el reino de Judá en el sur. Oriundo de Judá, Dios encaminó a Amós a que cruzara al norte, con un mensaje importante.

En el Norte regía en esa época un rey de nombre Jeroboam II. Bajo el liderazgo de este rey, el reino del Norte le fue muy bien económicamente, pero el origen de esas riquezas no fue del todo honrado. Gracias a esto, las riquezas aumentaron, pero también aumentó la desigualdad. Así como aumentó la riqueza para los ricos, aumentó el nivel de pobreza para los pobres. Se parece mucho a realidades de ciudades como Los Ángeles, o Barranquilla en Colombia donde viven personas muy ricas pero también viven personas muy pobres.

Amós, el profeta, tuvo la incómoda tarea de decirle al rey y a los ricos, que primero que todo estaba mal hacer dinero sin integridad, y segundo, que ellos tenían responsabilidad de compartir con los más necesitados.

El punto es este: el dinero no es malo si se gana de manera honrada. De hecho, con el dinero se pueden hacer muchas cosas buenas. Si Dios nos bendice, estamos llamados a fijarnos en aquellos que están desamparados, y en las necesidades de la Iglesia.
