Jesus, I trust in You

Today we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. We all want to be understood, forgiven and loved, and the answer to those longings is God's mercy. We belong to God because God has been merciful to us in Christ. Pope Francis ingeniously coined the idea that mercy is a verb. "In front of the loving gaze of God," said Pope Francis once, "we can not remain indifferent. We mercy."

We are indebted to St Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun from the 1930s, for the particular devotions associated to Divine Mercy. St Faustina's diary is still popular today and in it reads like a conversation between God and her. I'll share just one quote:

"When I look into the future, I am frightened, but why plunge into the future? Only the present moment is precious to me, as the future may never enter my soul at all. It is no longer in my power, to change, correct or add to the past; For neither sages nor prophets could do that. And so, what the past has embraced I must entrust to God. O present moment, you belong to me, whole and entire. I desire to use you as best I can. And although I am weak and small, You grant me the grace of Your omnipotence. And so, trusting in Your mercy, I walk through life like a little child, offering You each day this heart burning with love for Your greater glory."

Today at 2:45 PM we will have the Divine Mercy Holy Hour. It will be outdoors. The Jubilate Deo Children's choir will accompany us. For them to come, their parents requested not to use face masks. If you have not been vaccinated, for your safety please be sure to maintain more social distancing and refrain from having conversations with anyone not wearing a mask.

La Divina Misericordia

Quizás haya escuchado esta frase que dice provoca tanta confianza en el corazón que ama al Señor: "Oh Sangre y Agua que brotaste del Corazón de Jesús, como una Fuente de Misericordia para nosotros, en Ti confío." Son palabras de Santa Faustina.

El primer elemento de la Devoción a la Divina Misericordia que fue revelado a la Hermana Faustina fue la Imagen, el 22 de Febrero del 1931. Jesús se le aparece con rayos de luz irradiando desde su Corazón y le dice:

"Pinta una imagen según el modelo que ves, y firma: "Jesús, en ti confío". Deseo que esta imagen sea venerada primero en su capilla y luego en el mundo entero." (Diario 47)

"Prometo que el alma que venere esta imagen no perecerá. También prometo, ya aquí en la tierra, la victoria sobre los enemigos y, sobre todo, a la hora de la muerte. Yo Mismo la defenderé como Mi gloria." (Diario 48)

"Ofrezco a los hombres un recipiente con el que han de venir a la Fuente de la Misericordia para recoger gracias. Este recipiente es esta imagen con la firma: Jesús en Ti confío". (Diario 327)

"Los dos rayos significan la Sangre y el Agua. El rayo pálido simboliza el Agua que justifica las almas. EL rayo rojo simboliza la Sangre que es la vida de las almas..." "Ambos rayos brotaron de las entrañas más profundas de Mi misericordia cuando Mi Corazón agonizante fue abierto en la cruz por la lanza."

"No en la belleza del color, ni en la del pincel, está la grandeza de esta imagen, sino en Mi gracia." (Diario 313)

"A través de esta imagen concederé muchas gracias a las almas, ella ha de recordar a los hombres las exigencias de Mi misericordia, porque la fe sin obras, por fuerte que sea, es inútil." Diario (742)

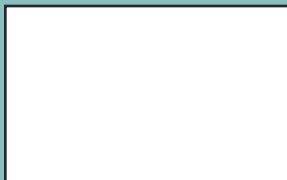
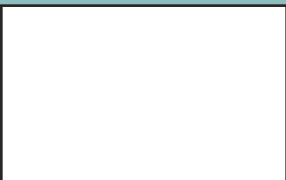
