### Sunday, April 18, 2021 — Third Sunday of Easter

#### Christ Walks with Us

On this Third Sunday of Easter, we hear once again the Emmaus story. This is one of my favorite passages in Scripture. Two dejected disciples of Jesus leave behind the community in Jerusalem, making their way to their old way of life without Jesus. Emaus represents the direction in life when we're going without any hope because of disappointments. The two disciples represent anyone who has ever lost hope, or anyone who was at first delighted with the ways of God, but then experienced disappointment, and lost her way. I have heard of people who due to painful experiences, lose hope in any connection to God through the Church. In the case of the two disciples on their way to Emmaus, that scandal and disappointment was the cross. Their hopes of Jesus had been dashed on the cross.

Then they meet a Stranger on the way. He begins to explain the meaning of the Scriptures and how various texts said that Messiah needed to suffer and die. They are so intrigued by Him that they invite Him to share a meal with them, and then the stranger becomes the one who breaks bread for them. The invited guest becomes the host, and they finally recognize Him as the Risen Lord. At that point he vanished from their midst.

The dynamic experienced by these two disciples was going from disappointment to an insight that changed their direction: they returned to Jerusalem. As our faith is tested through changes and even disappointments, Christ walks with us at each Mass, and offers us His own bread from heaven in the Eucharist, and prepares us first by His Word.
